- Medicine must be in original packaging from the pharmacy, including: controlled substances, liquids, inhalers, medicated ointments, patches, and pills.

What Not to Bring:

- Illicit Drugs (ex: cocaine, marijuana, etc.)
- Sharps objects including needles
- Radioactive medicines
- Bio-hazardous materials
- Glass thermometers or medical devices
