## **What to Bring:**

- Photo identification showing that you are at least 18.
- Any Rx or over the counter medications for anyone in your household.
- Medicine must be in original packaging from the pharmacy, including: controlled substances, liquids, inhalers, medicated ointments, patches, and pills.

## **What Not to Bring:**

Illicit Drugs (ex: cocaine, marijuana, etc.)  
Sharps objects including needles  
Radioactive medicines  
Bio-hazardous materials  
Glass thermometers or other medical devices
