Byrd Amendment Requirement for Anti-Lobbying Certification

1. Purpose: This Notice provides guidance to Public Housing Agencies regarding the submission of the Form HUD-50071, Certification for Contracts, Grants, Loan and Cooperative Agreements, as required by the Byrd Amendment.

2. Background: Prior to the issuance of the new revised Consolidated Annual Contributions Contracts (CACCs), which were transmitted under Notice PIH 98-21, housing agencies (HAs) were required to submit Form <u>HUD-50071</u> with their CACC whenever the HA executed an amendment to the CACC to add budget authority for increments exceeding \$100,000. However, the new revised CACC issued on April 7, 1998, eliminates the need for HUD to prepare a CACC on Form <u>HUD-52520</u> for execution by the HA each time new or renewal funding increments are added after the revised CACC has been executed by the HA.

3. Revised Submission Requirements: Henceforth, if an HA receives funds exceeding \$100,000 in budget authority, in any HA fiscal year the HA is required to submit form HUD-50071, Certification for Contracts, Grants, Loan and Cooperative Agreements, certifying that the HA has not and will not make any prohibited payment from federally appropriated funds. In addition, the HA is required to submit <u>Standard Form(SF)-LLL</u>, Disclosure of Lobbying Activities, disclosing any payment made, or agreement to make a payment, with other than federally appropriated funds for influencing or attempting to influence executive or legislative branch personnel in connection with new or renewal funding.

The forms must be submitted with each annual budget submission, which ensures that the requirement is met. HAs will not be permitted to draw on new renewal or incremental funding increments for the Section 8 programs until the Certifications are received by HUD. Ÿ

SUBJECT: Change in positions

We have recently had a vacancy in position #71, Range 23, Lieutenant, Services Division. According to our staff study performed by DMG-Maximus, Inc. the job duties of this position could best be performed by a civilian employee rather than a certified officer. I am proposing to not fill the Position 71 position but instead

Hire a range 12 clerical employee to perform job duties as listed on the attached sheet.

Hire a range 20 officer employee to assist the Patrol function of this department.

We will have savings in salary from this position 71 as well as savings in position 397 Investigator position, due to our receiving the Meth Grant, which allows us to place an employee retroactive to 1/1/01. This savings covers both of these positions for year 2001 with \$3,200. left.

The equipment for the officer, vehicle, mobile radio, portable radio, handgun will cost \$25,245. This would require year 2001 funding from the County of \$22,041. See attached worksheet. The funding cost for year 2002 would only be an additional \$10,037.00 over the budget of 2001. This would be for salary only as we will have purchased the equipment in 2001.

I will request to be on the Commission agenda, Tuesday, Harch 27, 2001 to discuss this with you.

On January 31, 2001, the County of Boone accepted 2 proposals for the above referenced services. These were submitted by HTE, Inc. and Advanced Institutional Management Software, Inc. (The evaluation committee consisted of Sheriff Ted Boehm, Major Warren Brewer, Carol Perry, Bob Ormiston and myself.)

Each firm was ranked on the following criteria:

- Previous experience,
- Skill, experience and time commitments to performing services
- Respondents understanding County requirements
- Cost, and 2
- Other information provided in the response.

Upon the completion of separate proposal evaluations the committee recommends awarding to HTE, Inc. for having the best proposal meeting the minimum specifications. Total amount budgeted for this project is \$165,000. The cost of the contract is \$157,251.00 including cost for expenses and extended maintenance for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> years to be paid out of organization 1251 account 91302.

By pre-paying three additional years of extended maintenance costs, we will be saving \$5,956.39.

Project Management Fees:	34% due upon contract execution, 33% due upon completion of first training session or 90 days from execution of contract, whichever comes first, and the remaining 33% due upon Go-Live of final application or 270 days from execution of contract, whichever comes first "Go-Live" is herein referred to as Customer's use of the Licensed Programs with real data in a production (and not testing) mode.
Conversion Fees:	50% upon the execution of the System Change Request (SCR) (includes \$250.00 processing fee noted below) and the remaining 50% upon completion.
Application Support Fees:	Prior to the commencement of the initial term of support. Support fees for subsequent terms of support will be due prior to the start of that term at the then prevailing rate. Rates for subsequent years of support service are subject to change.

#### Travel and Living Expenses: Travel and living expenses are in addition to the prices quoted above and will be invoiced as incurred and shall be governed by the HTE Corporate Travel and Expense Reimbursement Policy.

#### HTE Support Services

The initial term of HTE application support services shall commence one hundred twenty (120) days after delivery of the Licensed Program(s), and extend for a twelve (12) month term. Subsequent terms of support will be for twelve (12) month periods, commencing at the end of the initial support period.

#### **Application Training**

Listed above are the number of days of training for the Licensed Programs listed. Additional application training, if requested by the Customer, can be provided upon request at the standard billing rate in effect at that time, which at the time of this Supplement is One Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$1,280.00) per day. The fee quoted does not include travel and living expenses.

#### **Project Management**

A description of the applicable level of Project Management is attached to this Supplement and fees will be invoiced in the amounts and under the terms noted above. A mutually agreeable work plan will be created by the HTE Project Manager and the Customer. Additional Project Management, if requested by Customer, will be invoiced as incurred at the then current HTE daily rate at the standard billing rate in effect at that time. The fee quoted does not include travel and living expenses.

#### Conversion

Conversion, if provided for herein, or if requested by the Customer after contract execution, will be controlled by the HTE SCR form which will be prepared for the Customer by the HTE Conversion Team Manager. There will be a Two Hundred Fifty dollar (\$250.00) non-refundable processing fee for preparation of each SCR requested by the Customer. HTE will proceed on the SCR when the signed SCR is returned with the Customer's authorization along with fifty percent (50%) payment, which includes the non-refundable processing fee. The final fifty percent (50%) payment is due upon completion. Data must be given to HTE in an IBM compatible format on a specified magnetic media and must match data field definition. Input data file clean up shall be the responsibility of the customer. Additional conversion, if necessary, will be invoiced at the prevailing rate per hour. It is understood that no two systems and file structures are exactly alike and there may be a need for some manual conversion efforts to take place along with the electronic conversion. SCR form(s) for any conversion services included in this Agreement are attached for Customer signature and return to HTE.

#### **Cancellation Charges**

Customer acknowledges that HTE makes every effort to schedule training and project management sessions sufficiently in advance to make effective use of HTE's personnel and to obtain favorable prices for travel and living. Accordingly, the following cancellation charges apply to training or on-site project management sessions canceled at the request of Customer: cancellation within seven (7) days of start date, Customer pays fifty percent (50%) of the total price for the training or on-site project management; cancellation within three (3) days of start date, Customer is responsible for entire price of the training or on-site project management. In addition to the foregoing, Customer shall be obligated to reimburse HTE for any non-refundable expenses incurred by HTE for travel expenses. Notwithstanding the above, HTE will endeavor to reschedule HTE personnel in order to mitigate Customer's costs and expenses under this paragraph. To the extent HTE is successful in such rescheduling, Customer's payment obligations shall be reduced.

#### Publication

HTE reserves the right to publish certain information regarding this Agreement. Publication may include, but shall not be limited to, using Customer's name in a press release announcing this Agreement and listing Customer's name on HTE's complete customer listing that is made available to other HTE customers and potential customers.

#### **Preprinted Terms and Conditions**

Preprinted conditions and all other terms not included in this Supplement on any purchase order or other document submitted hereafter by Customer are of no force or effect, and the terms and conditions of this Supplement, the HTE Agreement, and the Hardware Purchase Agreement, if applicable, shall control unless expressly accepted by HTE in writing to the Customer.

#### Non-Hiring Statement

During the term of this Supplement and for a period of twenty-four (24) months after the termination of this Supplement, the Customer may not offer to hire or in any way employ or compensate any of the employees of HTE or persons who have been employed by HTE within the immediate past twenty-four (24) months without prior consent of HTE.



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
