

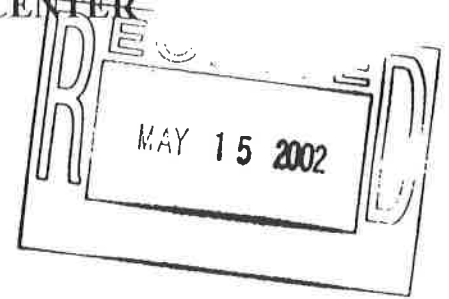

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Attached is a Budget Revision for the JAIBG Grant for Counseling Services.

In the original budget for the JAIBG Grant, all money was budgeted for Psycho-Educational Testing of youth at the Boone County Juvenile Justice Center. This money was budgeted in class 71101 Professional Services.

On April 11, 2002, we requested a budget revision from the Department of Public Safety taking money from Psycho-Educational Testing Budget for the development of Counseling and Testing Services and Family Therapy Services. The Department of Public Safety approved this revision on May 6, 2002.

The Counseling and Testing Services is for the purpose of providing services that will address testing needs, and providing individual and group counseling services. Due to the type of services, we believe that position needs to be covered under Worker's Compensation, which means this position needs to be classified as personnel, rather than contractual.

This requested revision does not require any additional County funds, no change in the total amount of any funds, and the Boone County Commission approved the Department of Public Safety's budget revision on April 11, 2002.



**PURCHASE AGREEMENT  
FOR  
DIGIAL CAMERAS**

**THIS AGREEMENT** dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 2002 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, herein "County" W. Schiller & Co., Inc., herein "Contractor."

**IN CONSIDERATION** of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

**1. Contract Documents** - This agreement shall consist of this Purchase Agreement For Digital Cameras, County of Boone Request for Bid for Digital Cameras, bid number 31-26APR02 Introduction and General Terms and Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, any applicable addenda, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, as well as the Contractor's bid response dated May 16, 2002 and executed by Gary W. Mabry on behalf of the Contractor. All such documents shall constitute the contract documents which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specification and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of conflict between any of the foregoing documents, Introduction and General Terms and Conditions of Bidding, Primary Specifications, Response Presentation and Review, the unexecuted Response Form, Standard Terms and Conditions, and applicable Addenda shall prevail and control over the Contractor's bid response.

**2. Contract Duration** - This agreement shall commence on the date written above until April 30, 2003 subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may be extended beyond the expiration date by order of the County for two additional one year periods subject to the pricing clauses in the Contractor's bid response and thereafter on a month to month basis in the event the County is unable to re-bid and/or award a new contract prior to the expiration date after exercising diligent efforts to do so or not; provided, however, that from and after the expiration date of this agreement any annual extensions thereof, Contractor shall have the right to terminate this agreement upon thirty days advance written notice of termination.

**3. Basic Services** - The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County the items identified and responded to. Items will be provided as required in the bid specifications and in conformity with the contract documents for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response, as needed and as ordered by County.

**4. Delivery** - Contractor agrees to provide the items and service as specified and as agreed to in the bid specifications.

**5. Billing and Payment** - All billing shall be invoiced to the Boone County Sheriff's Department or other requesting department and billings may only include the prices listed in the Contractor's bid response. No additional fees for delivery or extra services not included in the bid response or taxes shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in the Contractor's bid response to the specifications. The County agrees to pay all invoices within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts offered in its bid response if county makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the Contractor, the County agrees to pay interest at a

rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

**6. Binding Effect** - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.


**7. Entire Agreement** - This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

**8. Termination** - This agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:


- a. County may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or





### **Provisions Relative to All Cities and Towns**

#### **Section 71.270**

August 28, 1999

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#### **Streets, easements and commons in subdivision outside limits--petition --notice.**

71.270. 1. Whenever a tract or parcel of land, being outside the limits of any incorporated town, village or city shall have been subdivided and streets, avenues, roads, alleys, public easements, public square or common marked on the recorded plat of said subdivision, the county commission of the county in which the subdivision is located may vacate the streets, alleys, roads, public easements, public square or common or part of either upon petition of the owner or owners of the ground lying on both sides of or fronting on the street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common, or part of such street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common, proposed to be vacated.

2. No such vacation shall be ordered until proof shall be made to the commission of the publication in a newspaper published in the county or of written or printed notices posted in five public places in the county, at least fifteen days prior to the term of the commission at which such petition shall be presented, that application would be made at that term of the commission for the vacation of the street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common, or part thereof, as described in the petition. Such notice shall state distinctly the nature of the petition, when it is to be made, and what street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common or part of such street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common, is proposed to be vacated. Utility providers which provide service in the area of the street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common, or any part of such street, avenue, road, alley, public easement, public square or common, sought to be vacated shall be notified of the petition by the proponent of the petition.

3. If no person interested in such subdivision shall appear and show cause to the commission why the vacation should not be made, the commission may make the order for the vacation as requested in the petition.

4. In the event that the commission orders the requested vacation, such order shall be filed with the office of the county recorder of deeds.

The provisions of section 71.270 shall not apply to any state or county road established and opened prior to the filing of the plat of a subdivision; but such road, when marked on the plat, may be vacated by the county commission when it shall no longer be used and maintained as a state or county road, and the same, when vacated, shall vest in the person who may have the legal title thereof.
