**PUBLIC SAFETY JOINT COMMUNICATIONS
SECOND ASSIGNMENT OF LEGACY ASSETS AND
OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ASSET INVENTORY**

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the **City of Columbia**, hereinafter called the "City," and the **County of Boone**, hereinafter called "County," to provide for the City to assign certain leases, authorizations, and personal property in support of the County's assumption of operations of the County/City Public Safety Joint Communications, now known as Boone County Joint Communications.

WHEREAS, Boone County has assumed all costs and operational responsibilities associated with 911/Joint Communications as of January 1, 2014, after a County sales tax levy was approved by voters in April, 2013; and

WHEREAS, this assumption of costs and operational responsibilities by County has resulted in significant, annual savings to City in the form of reduced general fund appropriations to fund Public Safety Joint Communications (PSJC) as well as savings from other participants in the 1977 PSJC Cooperative Agreement, as amended; and

WHEREAS, prior to January 1, 2014, the assets of PSJC were purchased with funding received from the member agencies that were parties to the 1977 Cooperative Agreement that, as amended, included as parties the City of Columbia, Boone County, Boone County Fire Protection District, Southern Boone County Fire Protection District, University of Missouri-Columbia Hospital, and Boone County Hospital (hereinafter "Legacy Assets"); and

WHEREAS, these Legacy Assets acquired under the 1977 Cooperative Agreement were titled to the City of Columbia for inventory and insurance purposes; and

WHEREAS, these Legacy Assets are still needed for the continued, successful operation of the 911/Joint Communications systems and the PSJC participants have consented to the transfer of such assets to Boone County for the operation of Boone County Joint Communications; and

WHEREAS, as part of the transfer of the costs and administration of PSJC legacy assets, these Legacy Assets now titled to the City of Columbia must be transferred to Boone County for inventory, insurance, and operational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City and County previously agreed to the transfer of legacy assets relating to the radio system, emergency sirens, and a mobile command camper in an Agreement approved in Boone County Commission Order 374-2016 and Columbia City Ordinance #022830; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to agree on the transfer of additional legacy assets as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED by and between the City and County as follows:

1. **Transfer of Miscellaneous Legacy Assets from City to County.** The City hereby transfers and assigns to the County the following Legacy Assets purchased with the combined revenues from the member agencies to the original 1977 Cooperative Agreement that were titled to the City for inventory and insurance purposes, as set out in **Exhibit A** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein. Exhibit A and this Agreement shall constitute a Bill of Sale transferring title to the listed assets, which consists of miscellaneous office equipment. Prior to the County Commission's approval of this Agreement, County will ensure that adequate casualty loss insurance coverage is in place for the transferred assets and until such time the City shall continue to insure the property as per its past practice.
2. **Transfer of Legacy Computer-related Assets from City to County.** The City hereby transfers and assigns to the County the following Computer-related Legacy Assets purchased with the combined revenues from the member agencies to the original 1977 Cooperative Agreement that were titled to the City for inventory and insurance purposes, as set out in **Exhibit B** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein. Exhibit B and this Agreement shall constitute a Bill of Sale transferring title to the listed assets, which consists of IT-related computer hardware presently used by the public safety radio system which County now operates. Prior to the County Commission's approval of this Agreement, County will ensure that adequate casualty loss insurance coverage is in place for the transferred assets and until such time the City shall continue to insure the property as per its past practice.
3. **Office of Emergency Management Asset Inventory.** The parties hereby acknowledge the prior acquisition of the items set forth on Exhibit C which the parties expressly agree were acquired for the purposes of emergency management and response under the Columbia/Boone County Emergency Operations Plan. The parties agree to continue to use such items for the purposes for which the items were acquired and in conformance with the terms and conditions of any grant agreements which may govern acquisition, use and disposal. Custody of such assets may remain in the hands of the applicable agency listed on Exhibit C and may be shifted to any other agency as deemed necessary or appropriate by the Columbia/Boone County Emergency Management Director to further emergency response and recovery under the Plan
4. **Notification of Any Special Requirements.** City will inform County of any special requirements relating to tracking, disposition, or otherwise which originate from any grants used for the original acquisition of any specific asset which is transferred

pursuant to this Agreement and County agrees to assume responsibility for compliance with any such special requirements following transfer.

5. **Severability:** In the event that any one or more of the provisions or parts of a provision contained in this Agreement shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, in any jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect any other provisions or part of a provision of this Agreement, but this Agreement shall be reformed and construed in any such jurisdiction as if such invalid or illegal or unenforceable provision or part of a provision had never been contained herein, and such provision or part shall be reformed so it would be valid, legal and enforceable to the maximum extent permitted in such jurisdiction.
6. **Sole Benefit of Parties:** This Agreement is for the sole benefit of City and County. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to confer any rights or remedies on any third party.
7. **Relationship of Parties:** Nothing herein shall be deemed or construed by the parties hereto, nor by any third party, as creating the relationship of principal and agent, or of partnership, or of joint venture, between the parties hereto.
8. **Binding Effect:** This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors in interest and successors and assigns in office.
9. **Further Actions and Cooperation:** The parties agree to fully cooperate with each other in good faith to execute such further documents and take such further actions as are necessary to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of this Agreement.
10. **Authority:** The signatories to this Agreement warrant and certify that they have obtained the necessary authority, by resolution or otherwise, to execute this Agreement on behalf of the named party for whom they are signing.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 27th day of December, 2016, by and between the County of Boone, Missouri, through its County Commission, hereinafter called "County", and True North of Columbia, Inc. hereinafter called "Provider";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, County desires to purchase the following program service:

Shelter for Victims of Domestic Violence

as stated in the proposal, including any revisions, received by and on file with the County, which is hereby incorporated by reference as fully as if herein set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between County and Provider as follows:

I.

Provider agrees to furnish and County agrees to purchase:

Emergency shelter and supportive services for victims of domestic violence.

II:

Provider agrees that the services provided under this Agreement shall be provided to residents of Boone County and funds shall be spent as set forth in the FY2017 proposal on file with the County.

Provider certifies that this expenditure is essential to the provision of the services as described in Paragraph I.

III.

Provider agrees to submit to and maintain with the County current versions of the following required documents of the contracted entity: IRS Tax Exempt Status Determination letter; documentation from the Missouri Secretary of State indicating the entity is registered as a corporation in good standing; most recently completed IRS 990 or 990 EZ; financial statement and accompanying assurance completed within six months of the end of the entity's most recent fiscal year; organizational chart; board of directors roster; if applicable, an ADA plan of accommodation and a transition plan.

IV.

Provider agrees that the County shall be recognized as a financial supporter in all its promotional materials and advertising. A copy of the County logo will be used whenever possible.

V.

Provider agrees that it is responsible for all funds made available to Provider by this agreement and further agrees that it will reimburse to the County any funds expended in

violation of County, State or Federal law or in violation of this Agreement.

VI.

This Agreement shall not be assigned, and no services contained herein shall be subcontracted, by the Provider to any persons or entities without the prior written approval of the County. Any sub-contractor or assignee shall be subject to the audit requirements stated herein and all other conditions and requirements of this Agreement.

VII.

Provider shall be liable, and agrees to be liable for, and shall indemnify, defend and hold the County harmless from all claims, suits, judgments or damages, including court costs and attorney's fees, arising out of or in the course of the operation of this Agreement. It is the responsibility of the Provider to identify and maintain insurance coverage which shall meet the Provider's obligation to indemnify the County as set out above.

VIII.

Provider agrees to comply with all applicable provisions of: the Fair Labor Standards Act, as amended; the Employment Practices Act, as amended; the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended; the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended; the Omnibus Reconciliation Act of 1981, as amended; the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended; and all other applicable Federal and State laws which prohibit discrimination in employment and the delivery of services on the basis of race (racism), color, national origin, ancestry, sex, religion, disability, age (employment), and familial status (housing).

IX.

EMPLOYMENT OF UNAUTHORIZED ALIENS PROHIBITED

(a) Provider agrees to comply with Missouri State Statute section 285.530 in that they shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the state of Missouri.

For agreements in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000):

(b) As a condition for the award of this Agreement the Provider shall, by sworn affidavit and provision of documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with the contracted services. The Provider shall also sign an affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection with the contracted services.

(c) Provider shall require each sub-contractor to affirmatively state in its Agreement with Provider that the sub-contractor shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the state of Missouri. Provider shall also require each sub-contractor to provide Provider with a sworn affidavit under the penalty of perjury attesting to the fact that the sub-contractor's employees are lawfully present in the United States.

X.

County agrees to pay Provider the sum of \$27,695.22 (based on the cash balance available in Boone County Domestic Violence Account (Dept. #2030, Acct. # 86900) as of September 30, 2016) as follows:

A. The County will pay 50% of the contracted sum in January, 2017.

B. The County will pay 50% of the contracted sum in July, 2017.

XI.

Provider agrees to submit to the County an annual report, due by March 31, 2017, in the form and the medium proscribed by the County.

XII.

NON-APPROPRIATION CLAUSE: Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, all obligations of the County under this Agreement which require the expenditure of funds are conditioned on the availability of funds appropriated for that purpose.

XIII.

This Agreement shall be for a term of one year commencing on January 1, 2017 and ending on December 31, 2017; provided, however, that either party may terminate this agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice, in which event all reports required by the Agreement shall be submitted within thirty (30) days following the effective date of said termination.

XIV.

The signatories to this Agreement, by signing this Agreement, represent that they have obtained authority to enter into this Agreement on behalf of the respective parties to this Agreement and bind such parties to all terms and conditions contained in this Agreement.

XV.

There is no litigation, claim, consent order, settlement agreement, investigation, challenge or other proceeding pending or threatened against Provider or any individual acting on Provider's behalf, including sub-contractors, which seek to enjoin or prohibit Provider from entering into this Agreement of performing its obligations under this Agreement.

XVI.

RECORD RETENTION CLAUSE: Provider shall keep and maintain records relating to this Agreement sufficient to verify the delivery of services in accordance with the terms of this Agreement for a period of three (3) years following expiration of this Agreement and any applicable renewal.

AGREEMENT FOR PURCHASE OF SERVICES Therapeutic Mentoring

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 27th day of December, 2016 is made between Boone County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri through the Boone County Commission, on behalf of the Boone County Children's Services Board, herein "**BCCSB**" and **Presbyterian Children's Homes and Services**, a tax-exempt, not organized for profit organization or governmental entity, hereinafter referred to as **PCH**.

WHEREAS, the BCCSB, under the provisions of 67.1775 and 210.861 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, has the right to expend monies from the Children's Services Fund (CSF) for the purposes of funding services to children and youth 19 years of age and younger, and their families residing in Boone County; and

WHEREAS, the PCH has submitted a complete Request for Funding Proposal Application to the BCCSB detailing the services and other supports to be provided along with the expected cost to PCH thereof; and

WHEREAS, the BCCSB has approved the Request for Funding Proposal in whole or in part as hereinafter set forth,

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

FUNDING ALLOCATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY MGT

PCH is expected to the greatest extent possible to maximize funding from all other sources. PCH shall periodically, upon request, furnish to the BCCSB information as to its efforts to obtain such other sources of funding. PCH shall only request reimbursement for services not reimbursable by any other source. PCH shall not invoice the Children's Services Fund for units of service invoiced to another funding source. PCH shall provide documentation and assurance to the BCCSB that requests for reimbursement from the CSF is not a duplication of reimbursement from any other source of funding.

1. **BCCSB Funding Policy.** The BCCSB Funding Policy is to be taken as part of this formal contract and is incorporated as if fully set forth herein. PCH will perform the services and carry out the activities as set forth in the Request for Funding Proposal Application. PCH agrees to,

and understands that services performed under this agreement are limited to the Request for Funding Proposal Application.

2. **Contract Documents.** This agreement shall consist of the application for **Therapeutic Mentoring** as posted in the Apricot System.

3. **Purchase.** The BCCSB agrees to purchase from the PCH and PCH agrees to furnish **Therapeutic Mentoring** for children and youth nineteen years of age or less and their families, as described and in compliance with the original Request for Proposal and as presented in the PCH's response. Services/deliverables shall be provided as outlined in the attached proposal response(s). The total allowable compensation under this agreement shall not exceed **\$75,000.00** unless compensation for specific identified additional services is authorized and approved by BCCSB in writing in advance of rendition of such services for which additional compensation is requested.

4. **Contract Duration.** This agreement shall commence on the date of contract execution and extend through December 31, 2017 subject to the provisions for termination specified below. PCH agrees and understands that the BCCSB may require supplemental information to be submitted by PCH prior to any renewal of this agreement.

5. **Billing and Payment.** For the Purchase of Service (POS) Contract, the unit costs for services are the mutually agreed upon rates as follows:

All billing shall be invoiced to BCCSB monthly by the 10th of the month following the month for which services were provided. The BCCSB agrees to pay all monthly statements within thirty days of receipt of a correct and valid invoice/monthly statement. In the event of a billing dispute, the BCCSB reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount; in the event the billing dispute is resolved in favor of the PCH, the BCCSB agrees to pay interest at a rate of 9% per annum on disputed amounts withheld commencing from the last date that payment was due.

6. **Availability of Funds.** Payments under this contract are dependent upon the availability of funds or as otherwise determined by the BCCSB. This contract can be terminated if funding becomes unavailable in whole or in part for cause shown, and the BCCSB shall have no obligation to continue payment.

REPORTING, MONITORING, AND MODIFICATION

7. **Reporting.** The BCCSB shall utilize the Request for Funding Proposal Application and the Requests for Clarification, responses to Requests for Clarification, Requests for Additional Information, and Best and Final Offer Response, as submitted by PCH to monitor service delivery and program expenditures. PCH agrees to submit to the BCCSB an Interim Report by July 31, 2017 for the period beginning with the date of contract execution to June 30, 2017 and a Year End Final Report by January 31, 2018, for the period of the term of the contract. Variations on this date may be requested by PCH and, if so stipulated, are noted on this contract document. Payments may be withheld from PCH if reports designated here are not submitted on time, until such time as the reports are filed and approved. Reporting requirements will include but are not limited to information regarding agencies' outcomes and indicators, client demographic information, and other information and data deemed appropriate by the BCCSB. PCH agrees to submit its reports through the Apricot by *Social Solutions* funding management system or another format if requested.

8. **Audits.** PCH also agrees to make available to the BCCSB a copy of its annual audit within four months after the close of PCH's fiscal year. The audit must be performed by an independent individual or firm licensed by the Missouri State Board of Accountancy. The audit is to include a complete accounting for funds covered by this agreement in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. In addition, the BCCSB requires that the management report of any audit as it relates to BCCSB program activities be made available to BCCSB as part of the required audit. Payment may be withheld from PCH, if reports designated here are not made available upon request. Audits shall be uploaded to the Organization Profile in the Apricot System and continually kept up to date.

9. **Monitoring.** PCH agrees to permit the BCCSB, the Director of the Community Services Department and any staff of the Community Services Department, or designee of the BCCSB to monitor, survey and inspect PCH's services, activities, programs and client records, to determine compliance and performance with this contract, except as prohibited by laws protecting client confidentiality. In addition, PCH hereby agrees that, upon notice of forty-eight (48) hours, it will make available to the BCCSB or its designee(s) all records, facilities and personnel, for auditing, inspection, and interviewing, to determine the status of service, activities and programs covered hereunder, expenditure of CSF funds and all other matters set forth in the contract.

10. **Modification or Amendment.** In the event PCH requests to make any change, modification, or an amendment to funded services, one-time items, activities and/or programs covered by this contract, a request of the proposed modification or amendment must be submitted in writing to the Director of Community Services to share with the BCCSB for approval. A board resolution from PCH may be required with the request. For consideration of a

request to modify or amend the contract, requests to the BCCSB must be submitted in writing at least two weeks prior to a regularly scheduled BCCSB meeting.

OTHER TERMS OF THIS CONTRACT

11. **Violation of Client Rights.** Any alleged case of a violation of a client's rights in a program funded through the Children's Services Fund shall be investigated in accordance with PCH's policies and procedures and in accordance with any local/state/federal regulations. PCH agrees to notify the BCCSB through the Director of Community Services of any such incidents that have been reported to the appropriate governmental body and must also authorize the governmental body to notify the BCCSB of any substantiated allegations. PCH must comply with Missouri law regarding confidentiality of client records.

12. **Discrimination.** PCH will refrain from discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age, sexual orientation, genetic information, and familial status and comply will applicable provisions of federal and state laws, county or municipal statutes or ordinances, which prohibit discrimination in employment and the delivery of services.

13. **CSF to be used for Services Provided.** PCH agrees that the CSF funds shall be used exclusively for the services provided to children and youth 19 years of age or less and their families and for administrative costs directly related to PCH's provision of such services.

14. **Accreditation/Licensure/Certifications.** All organizations must comply with all state/federal certification and licensing requirements and all applicable federal, state, and local laws and must remain in "good standing" with the applicable oversight entity.

15. **Conflict of Interest.** PCH agrees that no member of its Board of Directors or its employees now has, or will in the future, have any conflict of interest between himself/herself and PCH, and this shall include any transaction in which PCH is a party, including the subject matter of this contract. Missouri law, as this term is used herein, shall define "Conflict of Interest".

16. **Subcontracts.** PCH may enter into subcontracts for components of the contracted service as PCH deems necessary within the terms of the contract. All such subcontracts require the written approval of the BCCSB or their designated representative. In performing all services under the resulting contract agreement, the PCH shall comply with all local, state, and federal laws. Any subcontractor shall be subject to the audit/monitoring requirements stated herein and all other conditions and requirements of this contract agreement.

17. **Employment of Unauthorized Aliens Prohibited.** PCH agrees to comply with Missouri State Statute section 285.530 in that they shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the state of Missouri. PCH shall require each subcontractor to affirmatively state in its Agreement with the

PCH that the subcontractor shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the state of Missouri. Provider shall also require each subcontractor to provide PCH a sworn affidavit under the penalty of perjury attesting to the fact that the subcontractor's employees are lawfully present in the United States.

18. **Litigation.** PCH agrees that there is no litigation, claim, consent order, settlement agreement, investigation, challenge or other proceeding pending or threatened against PCH or any individual acting on the PCH's behalf, including subcontractors, which seek to enjoin or prohibit PCH from entering into this contract agreement of performing its obligations under this agreement.

19. **Board Ownership.** If PCH ceases to be funded by the BCCSB or ceases to provide programs and services for Boone County children, youth and their families, pursuant to this contract, all capital equipment, materials, and buildings purchased with CSF funds shall be returned to Boone County unless so otherwise approved by a majority vote of the BCCSB. In addition, if PCH no longer uses capital equipment, materials, or buildings purchased with CSF funds for its original intent, PCH will need BCCSB approval to re-direct the use of such.

20. **Failure to Perform/Default.** In the event PCH, at anytime, fails or refuses to perform according to the terms of this contract, as determined by the BCCSB, such failure or refusal shall constitute a default hereunder, and the BCCSB will be relieved of any further obligation to make payments to PCH as set out herein. This contract will be terminated at the option of the BCCSB.

21. **Termination.** BCCSB may terminate this agreement at will by giving at least 30 days prior written notice to the PCH. This agreement may be terminated by the BCCSB upon 15 days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

a. BCCSB may terminate this agreement due to material breach of any term or condition of this agreement, or

b. BCCSB may terminate this agreement if key personnel providing services are changed such that in the opinion of the BCCSB delivery of services are or will be delayed or impaired, or if services are otherwise not in conformity with proposal specification, or if services are deficient in quality in the sole judgment of BCCSB, or

c. BCCSB may terminate this agreement should the PCH fail substantially to perform in accordance with its terms through no fault of the party initiating the termination, or

d. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year to fund this agreement.

22. **Indemnification.** To the extent permitted under Missouri law, PCH agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify the BCCSB, the County, its directors, agents, and employees from and against all claims arising by reason of any act or failure to act, negligent or otherwise, of PCH, (meaning anyone, including but not limited to consultants having a contract with the PCH or subcontractor for part of the services), or anyone directly or indirectly employed by PCH, or of anyone for whose acts PCH may be liable in connection with providing these services. This provision does not, however, require Contractor to indemnify, hold harmless, or defend the County of Boone from its negligence.

23. **Publicity by the Organization.** PCH shall notify the BCCSB of contact with the media regarding CSF funded programs or profiles of participants in CSF funded programs. PCH will acknowledge the BCCSB as a funding source whenever publicizing CSF funded programs. PCH will collaborate with the BCCSB to inform the community about the ways its tax dollars are being invested in services and supports. PCH agrees to acknowledge the Children's Services Fund as a funding source on all written and electronic publications including brochures, letterhead, annual reports and newsletters.

24. **Independence.** This contract does not create a partnership, joint venture or any other form of joint relationship between the BCCSB and PCH. The BCCSB does not recognize any of the PCH's employees, agents or volunteers as those of the BCCSB.

25. **Binding Effect.** This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

26. **Entire Agreement.** This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and other proposal or contractual agreement. This agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this agreement.

27. **Record Retention Clause.** PCH shall keep and maintain all records relating to this contract agreement sufficient to verify the delivery of services in accordance with the terms of the this agreement for a period of three (3) years following expiration of this agreement and any applicable renewal.
