THIS AGREEMENT, dated this M_{1} day of M_{2} day of M_{2} , 2018, is made and entered into by and between **Boone County**, a non-charter county and political subdivision of the State of Missouri by and through its County Commission, herein "Boone County" and the **Callaway County**, a non-charter county and political subdivision of the State of Missouri by and through its County Commission, herein "Callaway County".

WHEREAS, Boone County and Callaway County are or will be parties to a Memorandum of Agreement for grant funding from the FHWA-Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division for a bridge improvement project for Burnett School Road Bridge, a bridge that provides access to a United States Forest Service property, Mark Twain National Forest; and

WHEREAS, Boone County has agreed to contribute Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) to Callaway County in order to facilitate this bridge project; and

WHEREAS, at the completion of the construction project contemplated herein, the parties intend that the Burnett School Road Bridge will be regarded as part of the Callaway County's road system for all purposes thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the parties intend that Callaway County will administer this project (bidding, construction administration, construction inspection, and other project administration);

WHEREAS, the parties are empowered to enter into cooperative agreements for the purposes herein stated pursuant to section 70.220 and section 229.040 RSMo.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual undertakings and agreements herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- PURPOSE. The purpose of this Agreement is to facilitate the Burnett School Road Bridge replacement project.
- 2. BOONE COUNTY AGREEMENTS.
 - a. Within thirty (30) days of receipt of the invoice from Callaway County as contemplated in paragraph 3(b) below, Boone County will pay Callaway County the sum of Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) for Callaway County's use in connection with the Burnett School Road Bridge project.

3. CALLAWAY COUNTY AGREEMENTS.

- a. Callaway County shall proceed with the bridge replacement project for the Burnett School Road Bridge as contemplated in the Memorandum of Agreement with FHWA-Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division (EFLHD). Callaway County will, consistent with all grant requirements communicated by EFLHD, bid the project, award the project to the lowest and best bidder, and administer the construction project.
- b. At the time of Callaway County's bid award to a contractor to complete the contemplated Burnett School Road Bridge Project, Callaway County will prepare and send an invoice to Boone County for the \$85,000.00 project contribution contemplated herein by directing an invoice and proof of the bid award to Boone County at the following address: Boone County Resource Management, Attn: Stan Shawver, Director, 801 E. Walnut, Rm. 315, Columbia, Missouri 65201.
- c. After completion of the project contemplated herein, Callaway County will notify Boone County of the closeout of the project.
- d. After receipt of the payment of Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) from Boone County as contemplated herein, Callaway County accepts Burnett School Road Bridge as part of Callaway County's road system for all purposes and Boone County will not thereafter have any obligations with respect to Burnett School Road Bridge.
- 4. **ASSIGNMENT.** Neither party may assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement to any other person or entity without the prior, written consent of the other party.
- 5. **SOLE BENEFIT OF PARTIES.** This Agreement is for the sole benefit of Boone County and Callaway County. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to confer any rights or remedies on any third party.
- 6. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** Nothing herein shall be deemed or construed by the parties hereto, nor by any third party, as creating the relationship of principal and agent, or of partnership, or of joint venture, between the parties hereto.

- 7. **TERM.** This Agreement shall be in effect from its execution until completion of the project contemplated herein, unless sooner terminated under the provisions of this Agreement.
- 8. **TERMINATION.** If Callaway County has not awarded a bid on this project by December 31, 2019, then this agreement shall automatically terminate.
- GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri, and any action relating to the same shall be brought in the 13th Judicial Circuit.
- 10. BINDING ON SUCCESSORS. The covenants, agreements, and obligations herein contained shall extend to, bind, and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and approved assigns.
- 11. **COUNTERPARTS.** This Agreement may be executed by the parties in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original instrument.
- 12. **COMPLETE AGREEMENT.** All negotiations, considerations, representations, and understandings between the parties are incorporated herein, shall supersede any prior agreements, and may be modified or altered only in writing signed by the parties hereto.
- 13. AUTHORITY OF SIGNATORIES. Each of the persons signing this Agreement on behalf of either party represent that he/she has been duly authorized and empowered, by order, ordinance or otherwise, to execute this Agreement and that all necessary action on behalf of said party to effectuate said authorization has been taken and done.
