# PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING DEWEY M. RIEHN, CW2, US ARMY RETIRED

- Whereas, Dewey M. Riehn spend his adult life serving our Country and its citizens, beginning in 1956, when he enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps after his graduation from Jackson High School in Jackson, Mo.; and,
- **Whereas,** following Boot Camp, Dewey was assigned to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine Regiment, 3<sup>rd</sup> Marine in Japan and Okinawa, where he served until his discharge in 1958; and
- **Whereas**, in 1958, Dewey enlisted in the U.S. Army, where he was assigned to the Air Defense Artillery, Nike Missiles and served as Crew Chief in various locations in the United States and Okinawa until 1966; and
- Whereas, Dewey was recruited in the U.S. Army Counter Intelligence Corps (CIC) and attended the Special Agent Course in Baltimore, Maryland, after which he served as a Special Agent at various places in the U.S. including Enid, Okla.; St. Louis, Mo.; and Columbia, Mo.; and
- Whereas, Dewey also served as the Special Agent in Charge (SAC) of a special operations team in Vietnam from 1968 to 1969, and in Munich, Germany, from 1970 to 1975; and
- Whereas, during his years of service in Munich, Germany, Dewey worked toward his Associate Degree, Criminal Justice from University of Maryland, Munich Campus, which he earned in 1973; and
- Whereas, Awards and Decorations earned by Dewey included the Bronze Star, Vietnam Service and Campaign with four Bronze Stars, Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal, Army Commendation Medal and the Army Good Conduct Medal; and
- Whereas, following his retirement from the U.S. Army in 1976, Dewey became a Special Investigator for the Missouri Department of Social Services, where he worked 24 years in the areas of Fraud and Abuse and specialized in Crimes Against Kids and Child Abuse, until he retired as Special Investigations Administrator in 2000; and
- Whereas, Dewey served as the Legislative Chairman, Missouri Department of the VFW; as a member of the National VFW Legislative Committee from 2001 to 2017; and as the Vice Chairman and Chairman of the National Legislative Committee; and
- Whereas, Dewey has been honored to serve his fellow veterans by testifying hundreds of times before legislative committees in Jefferson City on bills pertaining to veterans' issues, lobbying congress in Washington DC on matters concerning veterans, and representing the VFW and MAVO (Missouri Association of Veterans Organizations) at meetings around the state; and
- Whereas, Dewey has enjoyed volunteering through various organizations, including service on the Board of Directors of the Missouri State Credit Union for eight years and service as a deacon in every church in which he has been associated since his ordination in 1966; and
- Whereas, Dewey's dedication to service and his community has impacted the lives of thousands of children of Boone County through his six years of service on the Boone County Children's Services Board, on which he has served since its inception in 2013; and

The Vendor agrees that he is fully informed regarding all of the conditions affecting the work to be done, and labor and materials to be furnished for the completion of this contract, and that his information was secured by personal investigation and research and not from any estimates of the County; and that he will make no claim against the County by reason of estimates, tests, or representation of any officer, agent, or employees of the County.

The said Vendor agrees further to begin work not later than the authorized date in the Notice to Proceed, and to complete the work within the time specified in the contract documents or such additional time as may be allowed by the Engineer under the contract.

The work shall be done to complete satisfaction of the County and, in the case the Federal Government or any agency thereof is participating in the payment of the cost of construction of the work, the work shall also be subject to inspection and approval at all times by the proper agent or officials of such government agency.

The parties hereto agree that this contract in all things shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri.

The vendor agrees that he will comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations and ordinances and that he/she will comply and cause each of his/her sub-vendors, and directives pertaining to nondiscrimination against any person on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in connection with this contract, including procurement of materials and lease of equipment; therefore, in accordance with the special provisions on that subject attached hereto, incorporated in and made a part of the Contract.

The Vendor expressly warrants that he/she has employed no third person to solicit or obtain this contract in his behalf, or to cause or procure the same to be obtained upon compensation in any way contingent, in whole or in part, upon such procurement; and that he has not paid, or promised or agreed to pay to any third person, in consideration of such procurement, or in compensation for services in connection therewith, any brokerage, commission or percentage upon the amount receivable by him hereunder; and that he has not, in estimating the contract price demand by him, included any sum by reason of such brokerage, commission, or percentage; and that all moneys payable to him hereunder are free from obligation of any other person for services rendered, or supposed to have been rendered, in the procurement of this contract. He further agrees that any breach of this warranty shall constitute adequate cause for the annulment of this contract by the County, and that the County may retain to its own use from any sums due to or to become due hereunder an amount equal to any brokerage, commission, or percentage so paid, or agreed to be paid.

The Vendor is aware of the provisions of the Overhead Power Line Safety Act, 319.075 to 319.090 RSMo, and agrees to comply with the provisions thereof. Vendor understands that is their duty to notify any utility operating high voltage overhead lines and make appropriate arrangements with said utility if the performance of contract would cause any activity within ten feet of any high voltage overhead line. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Vendor shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the County, its directors, officers, agents, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses (including but not limited to attorney's fees) arising by reason of any act or failure to act, negligent or otherwise, of Vendor, of any sub-vendor (meaning anyone, including but not limited to consultants having a contract with vendor or a subcontract for part of the services), of anyone directly or indirectly employed by vendor or by any subvendor, or of anyone for whose acts the vendor or its sub-vendor may be liable, in connection with any claims arising under the Overhead Power Line Safety Act. Vendor expressly waives any action for Contribution against the County on behalf of the Vendor, any sub-vendor (meaning anyone, including but not limited to consultants having a contract with vendor or a subcontract for part of the services), anyone directly or indirectly employed by vendor or by any sub-vendor, or of anyone for whose acts the vendor or its sub-vendor may be liable, and agrees to provide a copy of this waiver to any party affected by this provision.

# STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS - BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI

- 1. Contractor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and failure to do so, in County's sole discretion, shall give County the right to terminate this Contract.
- 2. Responses shall include all charges for packing, delivery, installation, etc., (unless otherwise specified) to the Boone County Department identified in the Request for Bid and/or Proposal.
- 3. The Boone County Commission has the right to accept or reject any part or parts of all bids, to waive technicalities, and to accept the offer the County Commission considers the most advantageous to the County. Boone County reserves the right to award this bid on an item-by-item basis, or an "all or none" basis, whichever is in the best interest of the County.
- 4. Bidders must use the bid forms provided for the purpose of submitting bids, must return the bid and bid sheets comprised in this bid, give the unit price, extended totals, and sign the bid. The Purchasing Director reserves the right, when only one bid has been received by the bid closing date, to delay the opening of bids to another date and time in order to revise specifications and/or establish further competition for the commodity or service required. The one (1) bid received will be retained unopened until the new Closing date, or at request of bidder, returned unopened for resubmittal at the new date and time of bid closing.
- 5. When products or materials of any particular producer or manufacturer are mentioned in our specifications, such products or materials are intended to be descriptive of type or quality and not restricted to those mentioned.
- 6. Do not include Federal Excise Tax or Sales and Use Taxes in bid process, as law exempts the County from them.
- 7. The delivery date shall be stated in definite terms, as it will be taken into consideration in awarding the bid.
- 8. The County Commission reserves the right to cancel all or any part of orders if delivery is not made or work is not started as guaranteed. In case of delay, the Contractor must notify the Purchasing Department.
- 9. In case of default by the Contractor, the County of Boone will procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the Bidder responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.
- 10. Failure to deliver as guaranteed may disqualify Bidder from future bidding.
- 11. Prices must be as stated in units of quantity specified and must be firm. Bids qualified by escalator clauses may not be considered unless specified in the bid specifications.
- 12. No bid transmitted by fax machine or e-mail will be accepted.
- 13. The County of Boone, Missouri expressly denies responsibility for, or ownership of any item purchased until same is delivered to the County and is accepted by the County.
- 14. The County reserves the right to award to one or multiple respondents. The County also reserves the right to not award any item or group of items if the services can be obtained from a state or other governmental entities contract under more favorable terms. The resulting contract will be considered "Non-Exclusive". The County reserves the right to purchase from other vendors.

- 15. The County, from time to time, uses federal grant funds for the procurement of goods and services. Accordingly, the provider of goods and/or services shall comply with federal laws, rules and regulations applicable to the funds used by the County for said procurement, and contract clauses required by the federal government in such circumstances are incorporated herein by reference. These clauses can generally be found in the *Federal Transit Administration's Best Practices Procurement Manual Appendix A.* Any questions regarding the applicability of federal clauses to a particular bid should be directed to the Purchasing Department prior to bid opening.
- 16. In the event of a discrepancy between a unit price and an extended line item price, the unit price shall govern.
- 17. # THE E-VERIFY MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR EMPLOYERS

# ARTICLE I PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY

The parties to this agreement are the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the CAPITAL PAVING & CONSTRUCTION LLC (Employer). The purpose of this agreement is to set forth terms and conditions which the Employer will follow while participating in E-Verify.

E-Verify is a program that electronically confirms an employee's eligibility to work in the United States after completion of Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification (Form I-9). This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) explains certain features of the E-Verify program and describes specific responsibilities of the Employer, the Social Security Administration (SSA), and DHS.

Authority for the E-Verify program Is found In Title IV, Subtitle A, of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (IIRIRA), Pub. L. 104-208, 110 Stat. 3009, as amended (8 U.S.C. § 1324a note). The Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 22.18, "Employment Eligibility Verification" and Executive Order 12989, as amended, provide authority for Federal contractors and subcontractors (Federal contractor) to use E-Verify to verify the employment eligibility of certain employees working on Federal contracts.

# ARTICLE II RESPONSIBILITIES

## A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE EMPLOYER

- 1. The Employer agrees to display the following notices supplied by DHS in a prominent place that is clearly visible to prospective employees and all employees who are to be verified through the system:
  - a. Notice of E-Verify Participation
  - b. Notice of Right to Work
- 2. The Employer agrees to provide to the SSA and DHS the names, titles, addresses, and telephone numbers of the Employer representatives to be contacted about E-Verify. The Employer also agrees to keep such Information current by providing updated information to SSA and DHS whenever the representatives' contact information changes.
- 3. The Employer agrees to grant E-Verify access only to current employees who need E-Verify access. Employers must promptly terminate an employee's E-Verify access if the employer is separated from the company or no longer needs access to E-Verify.

# 1. Introduction and General Conditions of Bidding

1.1. **INVITATION** - The County of Boone, through its Purchasing Department, invites responses, which offer to provide the goods and/or services identified on the title page, and described in greater detail in Section 2.

## 1.2. **DEFINITIONS**

- 1.2.1. **County** This term refers to the County of Boone, a duly organized public entity. It may also be used as a pronoun for various subsets of the County organization, including, as the context will indicate: *Purchasing* The Purchasing Department, including its Purchasing Director and staff. *Department(s)* or *Office(s)* The County Department(s) or Office(s) for which this Bid is prepared, and which will be the end user(s) of the goods and/or services sought. *Designee* The County employee(s) assigned as your primary contact(s) for interaction regarding Contract performance.
- 1.2.2. **Bidder / Contractor / Supplier -** These terms refer generally to businesses having some sort of relationship to or with us. The term may apply differently to different classes of entities, as the context will indicate.
  - *Bidder* Any business entity submitting a response to this Bid. Suppliers, which may be invited to respond, or which express interest in this bid, but which do not submit a response, have no obligations with respect to the bid requirements.
  - *Contractor* The Bidder whose response to this bid is found by Purchasing to meet the best interests of the County. The Contractor will be selected for award and will enter into a Contract for provision of the goods and/or services described in the Bid.
  - Supplier All business(s) entities which may provide the subject goods and/or services.
- 1.2.3. **Bid** This entire document, including attachments. A Bid may be used to solicit various kinds of information. The kind of information this Bid seeks is indicated by the title appearing at the top of the first page. A "Request for Bid" is used when the need is well defined. A "Request for Proposal" is used when the County will consider solutions, which may vary significantly from each other or from the County's initial expectations.
- 1.2.4. **Response** The written, sealed document submitted according to the Bid instructions.
  - 1.3. **BID CLARIFICATION** Questions concerning these specifications should be submitted in writing to the County no later than **July 15, 2019 by 3:00 p.m.** Contact for Bid questions Robert Wilson Buyer, Boone County Purchasing Department, 613 E. - 1.3.1. **Bidder Responsibility** The Bidder is expected to be thoroughly familiar with all specifications and requirements of this Bid. Bidder's failure or omission to examine any relevant form, article, site or document will not relieve them from any obligation regarding this Bid. By submitting a Response, Bidder is presumed to concur with all terms, conditions and specifications of this Bid.
- 1.3.2. **Bid Amendment** If it becomes evident that this Bid must be amended, the Purchasing Department will issue a formal written Amendment to all known prospective Bidders. If necessary, a new due date will be established.
- 1.4. **AWARD** Award will be made to the Bidder/s whose offer/s provide the greatest value to the County from the standpoint of suitability to purpose, quality, service, previous experience, price, lifecycle cost, ability to deliver, or for any other reason deemed by Purchasing to be in the best interest of the County. Thus, the result will not be determined by price alone. The County will be seeking the least costly outcome that meets the County needs as interpreted by the County. County reserves the right to award to more than one service provider. Multiple awards may be made on the basis of primary, secondary, and if necessary, a tertiary service provider. The primary provider shall furnish the County's requirements until such time as the County determines that it is in its best interests to seek performance from the secondary provider, then tertiary provider. The County's decision will be based upon ability of the primary source to supply acceptable goods and/or services within the County's time requirements. The County's decision to utilize secondary and tertiary sources shall be final and conclusive.

- 1.5. **CONTRACT EXECUTION** This Bid and the Contractor's Response will be made part of any resultant Contract and will be incorporated in the Contract as set forth, verbatim.
- 1.5.1. **Precedence -** In the event of contradictions or conflicts between the provisions of the documents comprising this Contract, they will be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:
  - 1) the provisions of the Contract (as it may be amended);
  - 2) the provisions of the Bid;
  - 3) the provisions of the Bidder's Response.
  - 1.6. **COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS** Bidder agrees to be bound by the County's standard "boilerplate" terms and conditions for Contracts, a sample of which is attached to this Bid.

- 2. Primary Specifications
- 2.1. **ITEMS AND/OR SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED** Boone County, hereafter referred to as "County", proposes to contract with an individual(s) or organization(s), hereinafter referred to as "Contractor" for a contract for the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, coordinating and scheduling, and related items required to provide materials for and/or perform Mill and Overlay work required of the bid items within.
- 2.1.1. **Scope of Services-** The Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and traffic control necessary to complete the following:

Asphalt Mill and Overlay: remove and replace asphalt for the parking lot of First Christian Church including butt joint milling and 2-inch overlay.

# 2.1.2. **Project Location:**

First Christian Church: 101 N 10th Street, Columbia, MO 65201

- 2.1.3. Contract Documents The successful bidder(s) shall be obligated to enter into a written contract with the County within 30 days of award on contract forms provided by the County. If bidder(s) desire to contract under their own written agreement, any such proposed agreement shall be submitted in blank with their bid. County reserves the right to modify any proposed form agreement or withdraw its award to a successful bidder if any proposed agreement contains terms and conditions inconsistent with its bid or are unacceptable to County legal counsel.
- 2.1.4. **Project Schedule-** It is the Contractor's responsibility to notify the County Facilities Maintenance Manager within 48 hours of starting the work. A project schedule depicting the progression of work must be submitted for the County's approval. Work should begin as soon as possible upon execution of contract and should be complete within the timeframe stated above.
- 2.1.5. PRE-BID CONFERENCE A pre-bid conference is scheduled for Thursday, July 11, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. at the Boone County Annex Conference Room, 613 E. Ash Street, Columbia, MO.
- 2.1.5.1. All potential bidders are encouraged to attend this conference in order to ask questions and provide comments on the Request for Bid. Attendance is not mandatory to submit a response; however, bidders are encouraged to attend since information relating to this RFB will be discussed in detail. Bidders should bring a copy of the RFB since it will be used as the agenda for the pre-bid conference. A walk thru/review of the job site will be conducted after the pre-bid conference.
- 2.1.5.2. Bidders are strongly encouraged to advise the Purchasing Department of Boone County within three (3) days of the scheduled pre-bid conference/site visit of any special accommodations needed for disabled personnel who will be attending the conference so that these accommodations can be made.
  - 2.2. **TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS** All materials provided and work done shall be in accordance with the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011.
  - 2.2.1. **Asphalt, BP-2, Virgin** (Item 4.9.1.): Plant mix pavement in conformance with Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011, Section 401. This mix will contain no recycled asphalt pavement or shingles. Contractor must submit a MoDOT approved Job Mix Formula no more than three years old. At County's discretion, this item may be placed in a single lift, or in multiple lifts (wedge/leveling course, surface course, etc.). Contractor shall be responsible for sweeping or other means necessary for cleaning of the street prior to performing this item.
  - 2.2.2. **Tack Coat**: (4.9.4.) (MoDOT section 407 Standard Specifications). Material shall be diluted asphalt emulsion such as SS-1, SS1-h, SCC-1 and CSS-1h or approved equal. Material shall be applied per Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011.

- 2.2.3. Surface Milling, Asphalt, Contractor Haul-off: (4.9.2.) Milling of asphalt surface to a depth prescribed by the County. Typical applications will be 1-3" deep depending on conditions. Contractor will be responsible for haul-off and retainage of millings.
- 2.2.4. **Bumper Reset** N/A
- 2.2.5. **Striping** Contractor shall restripe to match existing.
- 2.2.6. Additional Work: (Item 4.14.): Contractor selected for this contract should submit to Boone County along with their bid response a schedule of equipment that may be used and labor rates (billable hourly rate) for any additional work that may be encountered that is not contemplated by this contract but may be required to be performed because of unforeseen circumstances at time of construction. Under direction of Director or his appointees, contractor shall perform said needed work and account for equipment and labor utilized from said schedule and submit invoice for said work upon completion of project. Any material used to perform said work with no corresponding bid item in this contract shall be billed to the county for actual cost plus 20%.

#### 2.3. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.3.1. The Contractor shall be responsible for the removal and lawful disposal of all excess materials, and costs for said services shall be included in the bid price.
- 2.3.2. The Contractor shall complete all required utility locations prior to commencement of work.
- 2.3.3. The Contractor shall be responsible for accurately measuring the quantity of material required for the entire project. **Quantities listed in the Bid Response form are estimated**. The County does not guarantee minimum order quantities.
- 2.3.4. The Contractor shall comply with all Federal, State and Local laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations that in any manner affect the work. Special attention is called to, but not limited to, the local environmental ordinances. Ignorance of said laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations on the part of the Contractor will in no way relieve him from responsibility of compliance with all said laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations.
- 2.3.5. The Contractor shall be required to schedule project inspections with the Facility Maintenance Manager.
- 2.3.6. The Contractor shall provide all material safety data sheets prior to use of any hazardous material on the site.
- 2.3.7. The Contractor shall be responsible for the demolition and removal of any existing materials in the work area.
- 2.3.8. The Contractor shall be responsible for removing and replacing damaged surface during the project at no additional expense to the County.
- 2.3.9. The Contractor shall be required to remove all waste and debris and the site will be left clean at the end of each workday.
- 2.3.10. The Contractor shall be required to provide appropriate warning signs and barricades during the project to ensure public safety.
- 2.3.11. The Contractor shall provide new material of high quality that shall give long life. The workmanship shall be of high quality in every detail.
  - 2.4. WARRANTY –The Contractor shall be responsible for a period of one year from and after the date of final acceptance by the County of the work covered by this Contract, for any repairs or replacements caused by defective materials, workmanship, or equipment which, in the judgment of the County, shall become necessary during such period. The Contractor shall undertake with due diligence to make the aforesaid repairs and/or replacements within ten days after receiving written notice that such repairs or replacements are necessary. If the Contractor should neglect to begin such repairs or replacements within this period or in case of emergency, where, in the judgment of the County, delay would cause serious loss or damage, the repairs and/or replacements may be pursued by the County charged to the Contractor.

- 2.5. **PREVAILING WAGE** With submission of a bid response, Vendor acknowledges that any bid accepted over \$75,000 will be subject to Missouri Prevailing Wage law. The contract shall be based upon payment by the Contractor of wage rates not less than the prevailing hourly wage rate for each craft or classification of workers engaged on the work as determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of Missouri. The Contractor shall comply with all requirements of the prevailing wage law of Missouri, Revised Statutes of Missouri, Sections 290.210 to 290.340 including the latest amendments thereto. **The current Prevailing Wage Order #25 is enclosed and is applicable to this project.** The prevailing wage law does not prohibit payment of more than the prevailing rate of wages nor does it limit the hours of work which may be performed by any worker in any particular period of time.
- 2.5.1. If the bid accepted by the County for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work project is \$75,000 or less, then the Prevailing Wage Law will <u>NOT</u> apply to the contract.
- 2.5.2. If the bid accepted by the County for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work project is greater than \$75,000, then the Prevailing Wage Law <u>WILL</u> apply to the entire project.
- 2.6. **Change Orders**: If the County accepts a bid for less than \$75,000 for a "major repair" or "construction" of a public work and that contract is later subject to a change order that raises the total contract price over \$75,000, then the vendor is responsible for identifying that portion of the work causing charges that are in excess of \$75,000 and the Prevailing Wage Law WILL apply to only that portion of the project that is in excess of \$75,000.

  - 2.8. **BILLING AND PAYMENT** Payment will be made after the work has been completed and an invoice has been received along with required certified payroll records and affidavits of compliance. The contractor must submit an invoice and charges must only include prices listed in the contractor's bid response. Any additional costs associated with this project must be approved through the appropriate Change Order mechanism approved by the Boone County Commission. No additional fees or taxes shall be included as additional charges. The County agrees to pay invoices within 30 days of receipt of a valid invoice. Invoices should be submitted to Boone County Facility Maintenance at the above address referenced in paragraph 2.6.
  - 2.9. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS
- 2.9.1. **Insurance Requirements:** The Contractor shall not commence work under this contract until they have obtained all insurance required under this paragraph and the Certificate of Insurance has been approved by the County, nor shall the Contractor allow any subcontractor to commence work on their subcontract until all similar insurance required of subcontractor has been so obtained and approved. All policies shall be in amounts, form and companies satisfactory to the County which must carry an A-6 or better rating as listed in the A.M. Best or equivalent rating guide. Insurance limits indicated below may be lowered at the discretion of the County.
- 2.9.2. Employers Liability and Workers Compensation Insurance The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, Employers Liability and Workers Compensation Insurance for all of its employees employed at the site of work, and in case any work is sublet, the Contractor shall require the subcontractor similarly to provide Workers Compensation Insurance for all of the latter's employees unless such employees are covered by the protection afforded by the Contractor. Workers Compensation coverage shall meet Missouri statutory limits. Employers Liability limits shall be \$500,000.00 each employee, \$500,000.00 each accident, and \$500,000.00 policy limit. In case any class of employees engaged in hazardous work under this Contract at the site of the work is not protected under the Workers Compensation Statute, the Contractor shall provide and shall cause each subcontractor to provide Employers Liability Insurance for the protection of their employees not otherwise protected.

2.9.3. Commercial General Liability Insurance - The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, such commercial general liability insurance as shall protect it and any subcontractor performing work covered by this contract, from claims for damages for personal injury including accidental death, as well as from claims for property damages, which may arise from operations under this contract, whether such operations be by themselves or for any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by them. The amounts of insurance shall be not less than \$3,000,000.00 combined single limit for any one occurrence covering both bodily injury and property damage, including accidental death. If the Contract involves any underground/digging operations, the general liability certificate shall include X, C, and U (Explosion, Collapse, and Underground) coverage. If providing Commercial General Liability Insurance, then the Proof of Coverage of Insurance shall also be included.

Contractor may satisfy the minimum liability limits required for Commercial General Liability or Business Auto Liability under an Umbrella or Excess Liability policy. There is no minimum per occurrence limit of liability under the umbrella or Excess Liability; however, the Annual Aggregate limit shall not be less than the highest "Each Occurrence" limit for either Commercial General Liability or Business Auto Liability. Contractor agrees to endorse the County as an Additional Insured on the umbrella or Excess Liability, unless the Certificate of Insurance state the Umbrella or Excess Liability provides coverage on a "Follow-Form" basis.

#### 3.7 PROPERTY STANDARDS

- Cost of the property
- Percentage of Federal participation in the cost of the property
- Location of the property
- Use and condition of the property
- Disposition data, including the date of disposal and sale price
- \* Inventory. A physical inventory of the property must be taken and the results reconciled with the property records at least once every 2 years.
- Maintenance procedures. Adequate maintenance procedures must be established and used to keep the property in good condition.
- \* Control system. A control system must be in place with adequate safeguards to prevent loss, damage, and theft.
  - Promptly and properly investigate and fully document any loss, damage, or theft, and make the documentation part of the official project records. 2 C.ER. § 200.313 (d)(3).
  - Provide at a minimum, the equivalent insurance coverage for equipment acquired with Federal funds that the non-Federal entity owns. Federally-owned equipment need not be insured unless required by the award. 2.C.E.R. § 200.310.
    - Non-federal entities are responsible for replacing or repairing property that is willfully or negligently lost, stolen, damaged, or destroyed.
- \* Proper sales procedures. If authorized or required to sell the property, the recipient or subrecipient must establish proper sales procedures to ensure the highest possible return.

#### **Disposition of Equipment**

A State recipient must dispose of equipment acquired under the award in accordance with State laws and procedures.

Recipients and subrecipients other than States must dispose of the equipment when original or replacement equipment acquired under the award or subaward is no longer needed for the original project, or for other activities currently or previously supported by a Federal awarding agency, as follows:

- \* If the item to be disposed of has a current per-unit fair market value of \$5,000 or less, the item may be retained, sold, or otherwise disposed of with no further obligation to the awarding agency.
- If the item has a current per-unit fair market value of more than \$5,000, the item may be retained or sold, but the awarding agency will have a right to a specific dollar amount. Calculate this amount by multiplying the current market value or proceeds from the item sale by the awarding agency's share of the equipment (i.e, the agency's percentage of participation in the cost of the original purchase). The seller is also eligible for limited sale and handling costs of \$500 or 10% of the proceeds, whichever is less.
- In cases where the recipient or subrecipient fails to take appropriate disposition actions, the awarding agency may direct other disposition actions.

#### 3.7 PROPERTY STANDARDS

Equipment and Supplies Acquired With Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Funds

Special rules, set out in 42 U.S.C. § 3789 (a provision of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968), apply to the ownership, use, and disposition of equipment and supplies purchased with Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (Byrne JAG) funds awarded by the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). These rules supersede any conflicting provision of 2 C.F.R. part 200. See 2 C.F.R. Part 2800.

- Title to all equipment and supplies purchased with Byrne JAG funds vests in the criminal justice agency or non-profit organization that purchased the property, if it certifies to the State Office that it will use the property for criminal justice purposes.
- If such certification is not made, title to the property shall vest in the State Office, which shall seek to have the property used for criminal justice purposes elsewhere in the State prior to using it or disposing of it in any other manner.
- \* When equipment is no longer needed for criminal justice purposes, a State should dispose of equipment (for both the State and subrecipients) in accordance with State procedures, with no further obligation to the awarding agency.
- \* The procedures on use and management of equipment set out above apply to the extent that they do not conflict with 42 U.S.C. § 3789.

### Federal Equipment

When federally owned equipment is provided, the following requirements apply:

- \* Title remains vested in the Federal Government.
- \* The equipment must be managed in accordance with the grant-making component's rules and procedures and an annual inventory listing must be submitted.
- When the equipment is no longer needed, disposition instructions must be requested from the grant-making component.

#### Replacement of Equipment

December 2017

When an item of property is no longer efficient or serviceable but continues to be needed in the program or project for which it was acquired, or other programs permitted under <u>2 C.P.R. § 200.313(c)</u>, the property may be replaced through trade-in or sale and subsequent purchase of new property. In this case, the following conditions must be met:

- \* Same function and character. Replacement property must serve the same function as the original property and be of the same nature or character, although not necessarily of the same grade or quality.
- Timing. Purchase of replacement property must take place soon enough after the sale of the property to show that the sale and the purchase are related.
- Trade-ins. When acquiring replacement property, the recipient or subrecipient may use the property to be replaced as a trade-in. Value credited for the property, if the property is traded in, must be related to its fair market value. The recipient or subrecipient also may use the proceeds from the sale of the property to offset the cost of the new property.

Subrecipients of States. State subrecipients must obtain the written permission of the State to use the provisions of this section prior to entering into negotiation for the replacement or trade-in of property.

#### 3.7 PROPERTY STANDARDS

- Cost of the property
- Percentage of Federal participation in the cost of the property
- Location of the property
- Use and condition of the property
- Disposition data, including the date of disposal and sale price
- Inventory. A physical inventory of the property must be taken and the results reconciled with the property records at least once every 2 years.
- Maintenance procedures. Adequate maintenance procedures must be established and used to keep the property in good condition.
- Control system. A control system must be in place with adequate safeguards to prevent loss, damage, and theft.
  - Promptly and properly investigate and fully document any loss, damage, or theft, and make the documentation part of the official project records. 2 C.ER. § 200.313 (d)(3).
    - Provide at a minimum, the equivalent insurance coverage for equipment acquired with Federal funds that the non-Federal entity owns. Federally-owned equipment need not be insured unless required by the award. 2. C.F.R. 6 200.310.
    - Non-federal entities are responsible for replacing or repairing property that is willfully or negligently lost, stolen, damaged, or destroyed.
- Proper sales procedures. If authorized or required to sell the property, the recipient or subrecipient must establish proper sales procedures to ensure the highest possible return.

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- If the item to be disposed of has a current per-unit fair market value of \$5,000 or less, the item may be retained, sold, or otherwise disposed of with no further obligation to the awarding agency.
- If the item has a current per-unit fair market value of more than \$5,000, the item may be retained or sold, but the awarding agency will have a right to a specific dollar amount. Calculate this amount by multiplying the current market value or proceeds from the item sale by the awarding agency's share of the equipment (i.e, the agency's percentage of participation in the cost of the original purchase). The seller is also eligible for limited sale and handling costs of \$500 or 10% of the proceeds, whichever is less.
- In cases where the recipient or subrecipient fails to take appropriate disposition actions, the awarding agency may direct other disposition actions.

#### 3.7 PROPERTY STANDARDS

Equipment and Supplies Acquired With Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grent Program Funds

Special rules, set out in 42 U.S.C. § 3789 (a provision of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968), apply to the ownership, use, and disposition of equipment and supplies purchased with Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (Byrne JAG) funds awarded by the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). These rules supersede any conflicting provision of 2 C.F.R. part 200. See 2 C.F.R. Part 2800.

- Title to all equipment and supplies purchased with Byrne JAG funds vests in the criminal justice agency or non-profit organization that purchased the property, if it certifies to the State Office that it will use the property for criminal justice purposes.
- If such certification is not made, title to the property shall vest in the State Office, which shall seek to have the property used for criminal justice purposes elsewhere in the State prior to using it or disposing of it in any other manner.
- When equipment is no longer needed for criminal justice purposes, a State should dispose of equipment (for both the State and subrecipients) in accordance with State procedures, with no further obligation to the awarding agency.
- The procedures on use and management of equipment set out above apply to the extent that they do not conflict with 42 U.S.C. § 3789.

#### Federal Equipment

When federally owned equipment is provided, the following requirements apply:

- Title remains vested in the Federal Government.
- The equipment must be managed in accordance with the grant-making component's rules and procedures and an annual inventory listing must be submitted.
- When the equipment is no longer needed, disposition instructions must be requested from the grant-making component.

#### Replacement of Equipment

When an item of property is no longer efficient or serviceable but continues to be needed in the program or project for which it was acquired, or other programs permitted under <u>2 C.F.R. § 200.313(c)</u>, the property may be replaced through trade-in or sale and subsequent purchase of new property. In this case, the following conditions must be met:

- Same function and character. Replacement property must serve the same function as the original property and be of the same nature or character, although not necessarily of the same grade or quality.
- Timing. Purchase of replacement property must take place soon enough after the sale of the property to show that the sale and the purchase are related.
- Trade-ins. When acquiring replacement property, the recipient or subrecipient may use the property to be replaced as a trade-in. Value credited for the property, if the property is traded in, must be related to its fair market value. The recipient or subrecipient also may use the proceeds from the sale of the property to offset the cost of the new property.
- Subrecipients of States. State subrecipients must obtain the written permission of the State to use the provisions of this section prior to entering into negotiation for the replacement or trade-in of property.

#### MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION **COST APPORTIONMENT AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (hereinafter, "Commission") and the County of Boone (hereinafter, "Entity").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Commission owns and maintains Interstate 70 in Cooper and Boone Counties as part of the State Highway System;

WHEREAS, the parties desire the improvement or reconstruction of Interstate 70, extending generally 4.2 miles from approximately Sta. 1410+00 to approximately Sta. 125+00 (Equation: 1504+89.52 BK = 0+00.00 AH); and

WHEREAS, the Entity is willing to provide assistance in the construction or reconstruction of the improvements, subject to the terms and conditions herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representations in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- The purpose of this Agreement is to co-ordinate the (1) PURPOSE: participation by the Entity in the cost of the Commission's public improvement for Interstate 70, in the Counties of Cooper and Boone, designated as Job No. J5l3358. This public improvement will involve the replacement of the bridge over the Missouri River (L0962) near Rocheport, Missouri.
- **LOCATION**: The transportation improvement that is the subject of this Agreement is contemplated at the following location:

Beginning in Cooper County at approximately Station 1410+00, near the Route 179 interchange, run in a generally easterly direction along existing Interstate 70 to approximately Station 125+00 at State Route BB interchange in Boone County. (Equation: 1504+89.52 BK = 0+00.00 AH); Length of improvement is 21,990 feet (approximately 4.2 miles).

The general location of the public improvement is shown on attachment marked "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference.

- (3) <u>AMENDMENTS</u>: Any change in this Agreement, whether by modification or supplementation, must be accomplished by a formal contract amendment signed and approved by the duly authorized representatives of the Entity and the Commission.
- (4) <u>COMMISSION REPRESENTATIVE</u>: The Commission's Central District's District Engineer is designated as the Commission's representative for the purpose of administering the provisions of this Agreement. The Commission's representative may designate by written notice other persons having the authority to act on behalf of the Commission in furtherance of the performance of this Agreement.
- (5) <u>PROJECT RESPONSIBILITIES</u>: With regard to project responsibilities under this Agreement, the parties agree to contribute as follows:
- (A) The Commission will be responsible for the preparation of detailed right-of-way and construction plans and project specifications. This includes design, letting of project, and inspection of project. The plans shall be prepared in accordance with and conform to Commission requirements.
- (B) The Commission will acquire right-of-way as needed for the project in accordance with Commission requirements.
- (C) The Commission will be responsible for letting the work for the herein improvement, which includes advertising the project for bids and awarding the construction contract. The Commission will solicit bids for the herein improvement in accordance with plans developed by the Commission, or as the plans may from time to time be modified in order to carry out the work as contemplated.
- (D) The Commission will be responsible for construction of the herein improvements, which includes administration of the construction contract and inspection of the project work. The project shall be constructed in accordance with and conform to Commission requirements.
- (6) <u>PAYMENT RESPONSIBILITIES</u>: With regard to payment responsibilities under this Agreement, the parties agree to as follows:
- (\$2,000,000.00) no more, no less, no later than one month prior to the Commission's award of the project. This check should be made payable to *Director of Revenue Credit State Road Fund*. If the Entity fails to make the deposit, the Commission is under no obligation to continue with the project.
- (B) The Commission will be responsible for obtaining the remainder of the total project cost, currently estimated at two-hundred forty million dollars (\$240,000,000.00). Of this amount, the Commission shall provide two-hundred thirty-five million, eight hundred thousand dollars (\$235,800,000.00). The additional funds

currently estimated at four million two hundred thousand dollars (\$4,200,000.00) will be provided by other entities as detailed in Exhibit B.

- (7) <u>COMMINGLING OF FUNDS</u>: The Entity agrees that all funds deposited by the Entity, pursuant to this Agreement with the Commission, may be commingled by the Commission with other similar monies deposited from other sources. Any deposit may be invested at the discretion of the Commission in such investments allowed by its Investment Policy. All interest monies shall be payable to the *State Road Fund*.
- (8) <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>: The Entity shall not assign, transfer or delegate any interest in this Agreement without the prior written consent of the Commission.
- (9) <u>LAW OF MISSOURI TO GOVERN</u>: This Agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Missouri. The Entity shall comply with all local, state and federal laws and regulations relating to the performance of this Agreement.
- (10) <u>APPROVAL OF FHWA AND AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS</u>: This Agreement is entered into subject to the approval of the Federal Highway Administration and is further subject to the availability of federal and state funds for this construction.
- (11) <u>CANCELLATION</u>: The Commission may cancel this Agreement at any time for a material breach of contractual obligations or for convenience by providing the Entity with written notice of cancellation. Should the Commission exercise its right to cancel this Agreement for such reasons, cancellation will become effective upon the date specified in the notice of cancellation sent to the Entity.
- (12) <u>VENUE</u>: It is agreed by the parties that any action at law, suit in equity, or other judicial proceeding to enforce or construe this Agreement, or regarding its alleged breach, shall be instituted only in the Circuit Court of Cole County, Missouri.
- (13) <u>SOLE BENEFICIARY</u>: This Agreement is made for the sole benefit of the parties hereto and nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to give any rights or benefits to anyone other than the Commission and the Entity.
- (14) <u>COMMISSION RIGHT OF WAY</u>: All improvements made within the state-owned right-of-way shall become the Commission's property, and all future alterations, modifications, or maintenance thereof, will be the responsibility of the Commission, except as otherwise provided by this Agreement or a separate written agreement.
- (15) <u>NO INTEREST</u>: By contributing to the cost of this project or improvement, the Entity gains no interest in the constructed roadway or improvements whatsoever. The Commission shall not be obligated to keep the constructed improvements or roadway in place if the Commission, in its sole discretion, determines removal or modification of the roadway or improvements, is in the best interests of the state highway system. In the event the Commission decides to remove the landscaping, roadway, or improvements, the Entity shall not be entitled to a refund of the funds

contributed by the Entity pursuant to this Agreement.

- (16) <u>AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE</u>: The signers of this Agreement warrant that they are acting officially and properly on behalf of their respective institutions and have been duly authorized, directed and empowered to execute this Agreement.
- (17) <u>SECTION HEADINGS</u>: All section headings contained in this Agreement are for the convenience of reference only and are not intended to define or limit the scope of any provision of this Agreement.
- (18) <u>ADDITIONAL FUNDING:</u> In the event the Commission obtains additional federal, state, local, private or other funds to construct the improvement being constructed pursuant to this Agreement that are not obligated at the time of execution of this Agreement, the Commission, in its sole discretion, may consider any request by the Entity for an off-set for the deposited funds, a reduction in obligation, or a return of, a refund of, or a release of any funds deposited by the Entity with the Commission pursuant to this Agreement. In the event the Commission agrees to grant the Entity's request for a refund, the Commission, in its sole discretion, shall determine the amount and the timing of the refund. Any and all changes in the parties' financial responsibilities resulting from the Commission's determination of the Entity's request for a refund pursuant to this provision must be accomplished by a formal contract amendment signed and approved by the duly authorized representative of the Entity and the Commission.
- (19) <u>NO ADVERSE INFERENCE:</u> This Agreement shall not be construed more strongly against one party or the other. The parties to this Agreement had equal access to, input with respect to, and influence over the provisions of this Agreement. Accordingly, no rule of construction which requires that any allegedly ambiguous provision be interpreted more strongly against one party than the other shall be used in interpreting this Agreement.
- (20) <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT</u>: This Agreement represents the entire understanding between the parties regarding this subject and supersedes all prior written or oral communications between the parties regarding this subject.
- (21) <u>VOLUNTARY NATURE OF AGREEMENT</u>: Each party to this Agreement warrants and certifies that it enters into this transaction and executes this Agreement freely and voluntarily and without being in a state of duress or under threats or coercion.
- (22) <u>NOTICES</u>: Any notice or other communication required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed given three (3) days after delivery by United States mail, regular mail postage prepaid, or immediately after delivery in person, or by facsimile or electronic mail addressed as follows:

(23) <u>AUDIT OF RECORDS</u>: The Entity must maintain all records relating to this Agreement, including but not limited to invoices, payrolls, etc. These records must be available at all reasonable times at no charge to the Commission and/or its designees or representatives during the period of this Agreement and any extension thereof, and for three (3) years from the date of final payment made under this Agreement.

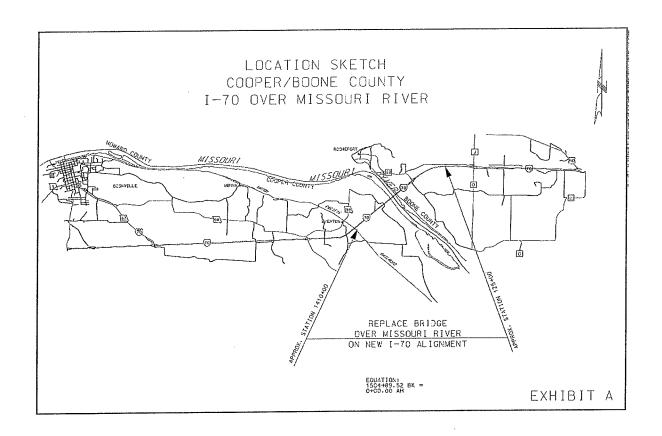
#### (24) INDEMNIFICATION:

- (A) To the extent allowed or imposed by law, the Entity shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Commission, including its members and department employees, from any claim or liability whether based on a claim for damages to real or personal property or to a person for any matter relating to or arising out of the Entity's wrongful or negligent performance of its obligations under this Agreement.
- (B) The Entity will require any contractor procured by the Entity to work under this Agreement:
- (1) To obtain a no cost permit from the Commission's district engineer prior to working on the Commission's right-of-way, which shall be signed by an authorized contractor representative (a permit from the Commission's district engineer will not be required for work outside of the Commission's right-of-way); and
- (2) To carry commercial general liability insurance and commercial automobile liability insurance from a company authorized to issue insurance in Missouri, and to name the Commission, and the Missouri Department of Transportation and its employees, as additional named insureds in amounts sufficient to cover the sovereign immunity limits for Missouri public entities (\$500,000 per claimant and \$3,000,000 per occurrence) as calculated by the Missouri Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, and published annually in the Missouri Register pursuant to Section 537.610, RSMo.

(C) In no event shall the language of this Agreement constitute or be construed as a waiver or limitation for either party's rights or defenses with regard to each party's applicable sovereign, governmental, or official immunities and protections as provided by federal and state constitution or law.
