EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI

THIS AGREEMENT dated the day of August, 2022, is entered into by and between Boone County, Missouri (County), and the Boone County Fire Protection District (Agency):

WHEREAS, County wishes to provide emergency communications services to all user agencies, citizens, and visitors throughout Boone County; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that Boone County Joint Communications is experiencing a staffing shortage that is causing a strain on current staff and risks the office being unable to meet its minimum staffing level requirements; and

WHEREAS, the County and Agency have the authority under RSMo §44.090to enter into mutual-aid agreements for the reciprocal emergency aid; and

WHEREAS, when operating under this Agreement, it is the intention of the parties that the Agency's employees or agents shall be subject to all provisions of law, and retain the same status as an employee or agent, as if those employees or agents were providing services within Agency's own jurisdiction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. AUTHORIZATION. The parties agree to provide mutual aid services in furtherance of the goal of providing reliable emergency telecommunications services to user agencies and occupants of Boone County. This authorization shall allow designated employees of the Boone County Fire Protection District to provide services for Boone County Joint Communications at the direction of Boone County Joint Communications staff.
- 2. EMPLOYEES/AGENTS SUBJECT TO AGREEMENT. This authorization shall extend to all employees and agents in good standing of Agency unless said Agency is notified by the Director of Boone County Joint Communications of a withdrawal of this authority as to any employee/agent, in the Director's sole discretion.
- 3. COMPENSATION. Mutual aid assistance provided under this Agreement shall be rendered without charge to County both during the conduct of normal business and in emergency situations.
- 4. LIABILITY. Each party shall be responsible for all claims, damages, and losses sustained by its own agency and personnel. Neither Agency or County shall be liable to the other for any action, failure to act, delay, mistake, failure to respond, negligence, or failure to effectively handle any policy problem arising out of any assistance provided hereunder. Agency's employees or agents shall be subject to all provisions of law and

- retain the same status as an employee or agent of the Agency, as if those employees or agents were providing services within Agency's own jurisdiction.
- 5. TERM. The term of this Agreement shall begin immediately upon execution of the same for a period of six months and shall automatically renew for successive periods of six months if not terminated as provided for herein. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing the other written notice of their intent to terminate at least 60 days in advance of the intended termination date.
- ASSIGNMENT. Neither party may assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations
 under this Agreement to any other person or entity without the prior, written consent of
 the other party.
- 7. SOLE BENEFIT OF PARTIES. This Agreement is for the sole benefit of County and Agency. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to confer any rights or remedies on any third party.
- 8. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** Nothing herein shall be deemed or construed by the parties hereto, nor by any third party, as creating the relationship of principal and agent, or of partnership, or of joint venture, between the parties hereto.
- 9. MODIFICATION AND WAIVER. No modification or waiver of any provision of this Agreement nor consent to any departure therefrom, shall in any event be effective, unless the same shall be in writing and signed by County and Agency and then such modification, waiver or consent shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose for which mutually agreed.
- 10. FUTURE COOPERATION. The parties agree to fully cooperate with each other to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of this Agreement.
- 11. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. The parties state that this document contains the entire agreement between the parties, and there are no other oral, written, express or implied promises, agreements, representations or inducements not specified herein.
- 12. AUTHORITY. The signatories to this Agreement warrant and certify that they have obtained the necessary authority, by resolution or otherwise, to execute this Agreement on behalf of the named party for whom they are signing.
