5. The specific violation of the Code is: trash, rubbish, and garbage in violation of section 6.5 of the Code.

6. The Health Director's designated Health Official made the above determination of the existence of the public nuisance at the above location. Notice of that determination and the requirement for abatement was given in accordance with section 6.10.1 of the Code on the 7 day of February 2023, to the property owner.

7. The above described public nuisance was not abated. 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

The Missouri State Agency for Surplus Property requires the County to complete and re-file an eligibility form every five years that allows the County's participation in the state Surplus Property program which also encompasses federal surplus property. The form requires Commission approval. There is no cost associated with participation in the state Surplus Property program.

Missouri State Agency for Surplus Property About the Program...

Eligibility

· 2) · * .

The Federal Surplus Property Donation program enables certain nonfederal organizations to obtain property the Federal Government no longer needs. The Missouri State Agency for Surplus Property (MOSASP) obtains this surplus property from the Federal Government and donates it to eligible entities for a service charge. Eligible entities include:

- Public agencies (State Agencies, cities, counties, schools, fire protection district, ambulance districts, etc.)
- Not-for-profit educational and public health activities (these must be licensed or accredited by a recognized authority).
- Agencies that primarily serve the homeless.
- Agencies that provide assistance to the needy.
- Agencies that receive funds from the Older Americans Act.
- Certain Veterans organizations.

To become eligible, forms must be completed by the chief administrative officer or executive head of the agency and MOSASP must make an eligibility determination. Once an agency is approved to receive property, the agency is called a donee. At that point, authorized representatives can visit the MOSASP facility and select property needed by the donee. Property is received on a daily basis so the inventory changes on a daily basis.

Service Educational Activities

Services Educational Activities (SEAs) are eligible to receive Department of Defense (DOD) property. Although their eligibility is determined by DOD, they should contact MOSASP for requirements. Property obtained by the SEA can only be used in their eligible program, and must be put into use within one year of receipt and used for at least one year.

Small Business Administration Participants

Participants in the Small Business Administration's (SBA's) 8(a) Business Development Program may be eligible to receive surplus property. The SBA will be responsible for determining eligibility and enforcing compliance.

Want List

To request property that is needed but not currently available, donees can place their names and the need items on the want list. When the property is received, staff will call and notify the donee that it is available.

Return of Property

- If at any time during the period of restriction, the property is no longer suitable, usable, or further needed by the donee, the donee must return the property to MOSASP.
- If property cannot be used and is returned within 30 days from receipt, full credit will be given. If property is returned between 30 and 60 days from receipt, half credit will be given. After 60 days, no credit will be given.

Hou is of Operation

The facility is open from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Restrictions

The Federal government requires that MOSASP place restrictions on property transferred through the donation program. Title to the property does not pass to the donee until it has been used for the period of restriction. A summary of these restrictions is as follows:

- Property can only be used by the eligible donee.
- Property obtained must be put into use within one year of receipt and remain in use for at least one year.
- Passenger motor vehicles and items with an original acquisition cost of \$5,000 or more must be used for a minimum period of 18 months.
- · Gas masks, body armor, aircraft, vessels, and foreign gifts have an additional period of restriction.
- Personal use, unauthorized sale, disposal, cannibalization or destruction of property during the restriction period is considered noncompliance.
- · Property cannot be stored at a personal residence without the prior written approval of MOSASP.

Compliance

MOSASP is required to verify compliance with the regulations. This is done by mailing utilization report forms and by making random unannounced compliance visits. During the compliance visits, we ask to see the property in use.

State Surplus Property

In addition to the federal donation program, MOSASP operates the State surplus property program. This provides an opportunity for the same donees to obtain surplus property from the state agencies. State surplus property must be obtained for use by the eligible donees.

Fixed Price Vehicle Program

Under the fixed price program, MOSASP purchases vehicles form the Federal Government. These vehicles are then resold to eligible donees. The vehicles are typically lower mileage and later model year than those found through the donation program. These vehicles must be obtained for use by the eligible donee.

Entity Structure and Organization

Boone County is situated in Central Missouri and is dissected by Interstate 70 and US Highway 63. It is a fast-growing county known for its highly educated work force, low cost of living, award-winning schools, and unique blend of rural and urban lifestyles. The County covers 685 square miles and contains thirteen population centers consisting of cities, towns, villages, and small communities. The City of Columbia, the largest population center in the county, is the county seat. The County is empowered to levy a property tax on both real and personal property located within its boundaries.

The County was organized in 1821 under applicable state statutes and continues under the same form of government to this day. The structure and operations of the County are governed by state statute rather than by local charter with many of the County's daily operations supervised by full-time elected officials serving four-year terms of office. These elected officials include the Sheriff, Prosecuting Attorney, Recorder of Deeds, Collector of Revenue, Auditor, Assessor, County Clerk, Treasurer, Public Administrator, and County Commissioners. In addition, the Circuit Court Clerk, Associate Circuit Judges, and Circuit Court Judges are elected to four-year terms; however, their salaries are paid by the state.

To the extent allowed by state statute, policymaking and legislative authority are vested in the County Commission, which consists of a Presiding Commissioner and two Associate Commissioners, each of whom serve full time and are elected to fouryear terms. The County Commission is responsible, among other things, for passing ordinances, appointing committees, and hiring certain departmental directors and managers (Information Technology, Resource Management, Road and Bridge Maintenance Operations, Human Resources and Risk Management, Purchasing, and Facilities Maintenance). The Commission also appoints the Medical Examiner and the County Counselor (legal advisor). The County Commission is responsible for all County property and for adopting the annual budget. The County Commission has appropriating authority for the County's major operating funds as well as numerous special revenue funds, debt service funds, capital project funds, and internal service funds. However, individual elected officials other than the Commission have appropriating authority over numerous special revenue funds, all of which are included in the annual budget. The Presiding Commissioner is elected at large and the two Associate Commissioners are each elected from within their respective district. All other elected officials also serve four-year terms and are elected at large.

Boone County's geographic position, its plentiful natural resources, the largely southern culture of its early settlers, and the cautious but progressive approach to changing world conditions that characterized its ever-growing population have combined to make it one of the major players in Missouri's colorful history.

At the beginning of the 19th century, it was a region populated by Native Americans. Its largely uncharted land made up part of the Louisiana Purchase of 1803 which was explored by Meriwether Lewis and William Clark the following year. An even earlier resident was Daniel Boone, already a legendary explorer and frontiersman when he immigrated to the wilderness on the Femme Osage Creek in St. Charles County in 1795.

Daniel Boone's death at Marthasville in 1820 came but two weeks before the territorial legislature (their members wearing black arm bands to honor his memory) acted favorably on petitions to organize a new territorial county to be named in Boone's honor, one of 39 counties eventually carved from a once-gigantic Howard County land area. Ironically, it's not clear whether Daniel Boone ever visited the county named in his honor, although his sons, Nathan and Daniel M. established a salt lick in adjacent Howard County and the road between St. Charles and the newly-settled county was the "Boons' Lick road" without the "e." (In fact, historians differ not only as to the precise date of Daniel Boone's birth, but also whether his last name ended with an "e". The "e" won largely because of documents bearing his signature.)

Records indicate the first immigrants to the area were mostly southern in makeup, largely from Kentucky; those origins influenced the social and economic development of the area, creating an early interest in education, the arts and politics even amidst the harsh frontier living conditions. The first known white settlement, founded in the winter of 1812, was at Thrall's Prairie, 12 miles northwest of present-day Columbia and four miles north of Rocheport.

Boone was organized as a "territorial county" in September, 1820, nine months before Congress bestowed statehood on Missouri. The population at that time was 3,692. By 1830, it was 8.859; by 1850, nearly 15,000; by 1860, nearly 19,500; and by 1880, the population had grown to more than 25,000. A group of investors formed the Smithton Land Company to develop a "seat of justice" (county seat) for the intended new county and in the winter of 1818-19, laid out the village of Smithton roughly around presentday Garth and Walnut streets in Columbia. However, an inadequate water supply aborted Smithton's growth. Residents moved a half mile east across Flat Branch Creek to create the new town of Columbia, using the same grid format and claiming a name then in use in some variation in 32 states. Columbia's first house was a cabin built at 5th and Broadway in 1820-21. A growing population and expanded commerce due to steamboat access to St. Louis suggested a prosperous future for the towns of Rocheport and Persia; the latter even competed to be the county seat. However, the building of a rail line from St. Charles through northern Boone County replaced the steamboat as a major carrier of goods and passengers. Today, Rocheport is a village showing renewed vigor as a tourist attraction and antique-collectors' paradise. Persia no longer exists.

As early as 1820, the Act of Congress authorizing the people of Missouri to draft a state constitution and to form a state government included a provision setting aside land for a "seminary of learning". The first state constitution adopted that year provided for "a university" and the means to fund it. Months of legislative maneuvering, lobbying, and pledges of funds from counties wanting to host the site of

the university culminated with the General Assembly's designation in 1839 of Columbia. Boone County residents had pledged more than \$117,000—more than any of the competing counties. A major contributor was James S. Rollins, a prominent figure in Boone County history (at various times a member of the General Assembly, the U.S. House of Representatives, United States Senator, and member of the University Board of Curators). His pledge included much of his own land holdings (now part of the campus). Lesser known was Edward Camplin, a man who could neither read nor write but pledged \$3,000, a sizeable amount at the time. His contribution, and those of numerous other county residents, reflected not only the excitement of competition, but also the vast community support for higher education. Crowds of on-lookers demonstrated that interest again at the dedication July 4, 1843, of the new "principal edifice," the administration/classroom/museum building that subsequently burned in 1892 when again the pledges of townspeople led to the decision to rebuild the university in Columbia.

Boone County was a slave-holding county in the middle of the only slave-holding state west of the Mississippi River. Except for brief periods of time, Columbia was occupied by Union forces from December 1861 until August 1865. For a time in 1862, the University closed and its buildings were occupied by the military. Boone's population, like that of the state as a whole, was split on the slavery issue; a "Southern Rights" meeting in April 1861 adopted resolutions condemning President Lincoln, supporting "our southern brethren," and urging Missouri join the other southern states in secession. A "Union meeting" a few weeks later adopted resolutions pledging support of the Union and urging Missouri to remain neutral in the Civil War, but to be prepared to defend against invaders. There were skirmishes in and about Boone County, but the main battles were elsewhere. In 1864, as "bushwhackers" became a major problem, one such group perpetrated the Centralia Massacre. A band of guerillas lead by Bill Anderson robbed and plundered the town of Centralia on September 27, 1864 and then ambushed a train carrying about 150 passengers, including 23 newly discharged federal soldiers. The soldiers were ordered to leave the train, line up, were stripped and shot, their papers and personal effects removed. The train and depot were burned. A few hours later, a detachment of federal troops in pursuit of the guerillas rode into a trap and 108 more were killed. While exact figures as to the number of Boone County men involved in the war are not known, it's estimated about 500 wore Union blue and an equal number Confederate Gray.

The Boons' Lick road gave way to U.S. Highway 40, which largely was replaced with Interstate 70; that part of I-70 in Missouri was the first statewide section of interstate highway to be completed. Boone's strategic and easily-accessible location, midway between St. Louis and Kansas City and 30 miles from the Capitol at Jefferson City, together with its educational and medical facilities, its professional and business economy and its non-polluting industries, have made it one of Missouri's fastestgrowing counties. Columbia consistently has been ranked by various national publications as "one of the best" places to live, to retire, and to raise a family. Its cost of living is below the national average and its public schools rank among the best in a town internationally known as the "Athens of Missouri" because it's the home of the state university, Columbia College, and Stephens College.

The Purchasing Departments requests permission to dispose of the following list of surplus PC'S, peripheral equipment, unworking air conditioners, file cabinets, and other miscellaneous items through MRC Recycling Center. MRC Recycling will pick up our surplus for fifty dollars per load. Tubed monitors and TV's cost extra. There is also an extra charge for items with freon. They are a State of Missouri, DNR Level Four recycling center. No computer items are land-filled. Purchasing will obtain a Certificate of Destruction, and we will let them know that we want everything recycled, not reused so nothing ends up in the landfill.

Prior to Computer surplus coming to Purchasing for disposal, Information Technology has removed the hard drives for destruction by their department. Their procedure for PC disposal is:

Once all the data is copied or recovered for the user, IT removes the hard drive and memory from the PC. The memory is held to be used for upgrading other PCs at the county that can benefit. IT sometimes removes parts that can be used as spare if the model is current enough. (ie Power Supplies, Video Cards, etc.) The hard drive is held for a minimum of 30 days in case a user identifies something is missing. After 30 days IT may reuse the hard drive in other county PCs if there are failures. If a hard drive goes unused or fails and IT needs to physically dispose of it, they drill a 5/8" hole through the drive and the data platters. Once IT has collection of "drilled" drives, they deliver them to PC recycling vendor, MRC Recycling Center.

MRC Recycling Center certifies that they have picked up the following items and that all items will be recycled, not reused, so nothing ends up in the landfill.





STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS - CONTRACT WITH BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI

- 1. Contractor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and failure to do so, in County's sole discretion, shall give County the right to terminate this Contract.
- 2. Prices shall include all charges for packing, delivery, installation, etc., (unless otherwise specified) to the Boone County Department.
- 3. The Boone County Commission has the right to accept or reject any part or parts of all bids, to waive technicalities, and to accept the offer the County Commission considers the most advantageous to the County. Boone County reserves the right to award this bid on an item-by-item basis, or an "all or none" basis, whichever is in the best interest of the County. The Purchasing Director reserves the right, when only one bid has been received by the bid closing date, to delay the opening of bids to another date and time in order to revise specifications and/or establish further competition for the commodity or service required. The one (1) bid received will be retained unopened until the new Closing date, or at request of bidder, returned unopened for re-submittal at the new date and time of bid closing.
- 4. When products or materials of any particular producer or manufacturer are mentioned in our contracts, such products or materials are intended to be descriptive of type or quality and not restricted to those mentioned.
- 5. Do not include Federal Excise Tax or Sales and Use Taxes in billing, as law exempts the County from them.
- 6. The delivery date shall be stated in definite terms.
- 7. The County Commission reserves the right to cancel all or any part of orders if delivery is not made or work is not started as guaranteed. In case of delay, the Contractor must notify the Purchasing Department.
- 8. In case of default by the Contractor, the County of Boone will procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the Contractor responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.
- 9. Failure to deliver as guaranteed may disqualify Contractor from future bidding.
- 10. Prices must be as stated in units of quantity specified and must be firm.
- 11. The County of Boone, Missouri expressly denies responsibility for, or ownership of any item purchased until same is delivered to the County and is accepted by the County.
- 12. The County reserves the right to award to one or multiple respondents. The County also reserves the right to not award any item or group of items if the services can be obtained from a state or other governmental entities contract under more favorable terms. The resulting contract will be considered "Non-Exclusive". The County reserves the right to purchase advertising from other vendors.
- 13. The County, from time to time, uses federal grant funds for the procurement of goods and services. Accordingly, the provider of goods and/or services shall comply with federal laws, rules and regulations applicable to the funds used by the County for said procurement, and contract clauses required by the federal government in such circumstances are incorporated herein by reference. These clauses can generally be found in the Federal Transit Administration's Best Practices Procurement Manual – Appendix A. Any questions regarding the applicability of federal clauses to a particular bid should be directed to the Purchasing Department prior to bid opening.

- 14. In the event of a discrepancy between a unit price and an extended line item price, the unit price shall govern.
- 15. Should an audit of Contractor's invoices during the term of the Agreement, and any renewals thereof, indicate that the County has remitted payment on invoices that constitute an over-charging to the County above the pricing terms agreed to herein, the Contractor shall issue a refund check to the County for any over-charges within 30-days of being notified of the same.
- 16. Pursuant to Section 34.600 RSMo, for contracts \$100,000 and greater, Contractor/Vendor certifies it is not currently engaged in and shall not, for the duration of the contract, engage in a boycott of goods or services from the State of Israel; companies doing business in or with Israel or authorized by, licensed by, or organized under the laws of the State of Israel; or persons or entities doing business in the State of Israel.
- 17. **For all titled vehicles and equipment, the dealer must use the actual delivery date to the County** on all transfer documents including the Certificate of Origin (COO), Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO), Bill of Sale (BOS), and Application for Title.
- 18. **Equipment and serial and model numbers -** The contractor is strongly encouraged to include equipment serial and model numbers for all amounts invoiced to the County. If equipment serial and model numbers are not provided on the face of the invoice, such information may be required by the County before issuing payment.
- 19. All equipment and supplies offered in a quote must be new, of current production, and available for marketing by the manufacturer unless the County clearly specifies that used, reconditioned, or remanufactured equipment and supplies may be offered.

Insurance Requirements: The Contractor shall not commence work under this contract until they have obtained all insurance required under this paragraph and the Certificate of Insurance has been approved by the County, nor shall the Contractor allow any subcontractor to commence work on their subcontract until all similar insurance required of subcontractor has been so obtained and approved. All policies shall be in amounts, form and companies satisfactory to the County which must carry an A-6 or better rating as listed in the A.M. Best or equivalent rating guide.

Employers Liability and Workers Compensation Insurance - The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, Employers Liability and Workers Compensation Insurance for all of its employees employed at the site of work, and in case any work is sublet, the Contractor shall require the subcontractor similarly to provide Workers Compensation Insurance for all of the latter's employees unless such employees are covered by the protection afforded by the Contractor. Workers Compensation coverage shall meet Missouri statutory limits. Employers Liability limits shall be \$500,000.00 each employee, \$500,000.00 each accident, and \$500,000.00 policy limit. In case any class of employees engaged in hazardous work under this Contract at the site of the work is not protected under the Workers Compensation Statute, the Contractor shall provide and shall cause each subcontractor to provide Employers Liability Insurance for the protection of their employees not otherwise protected.

Commercial General Liability Insurance - The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, such commercial general liability insurance as shall protect it and any subcontractor performing work covered by this contract, from claims for damages for personal & advertising injury, bodily injury including accidental death, as well as from claims for property damages, which may arise from operations under this contract, whether such operations be by themselves or for any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by them. The amounts of insurance shall be not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate covering both bodily injury and property damage, including accidental death. If the Contract involves any underground/digging operations, the general liability certificate shall include X, C, and U (Explosion, Collapse, and Underground) coverage. If providing Commercial General Liability Insurance, then the Proof of Coverage of Insurance shall also be included.

Contractor may satisfy the minimum liability limits required for Commercial General Liability or Business Auto Liability under an Umbrella or Excess Liability policy. There is no minimum per occurrence limit of liability under the umbrella or Excess Liability; however, the Annual Aggregate limit shall not be less than the highest "Each Occurrence" limit for either Commercial General Liability or Business Auto Liability. Contractor agrees to endorse the County as an Additional Insured on the umbrella or Excess Liability, unless the Certificate of Insurance state the Umbrella or Excess Liability provides coverage on a "Follow-Form" basis.

Business Automobile Liability – The Contractor shall maintain during the life of this contract, automobile liability insurance in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for any one occurrence, covering both bodily injury, including accidental death, and property damage, to protect themselves from any and all claims arising from the use of the Contractor's own automobiles, teams and trucks; hired automobiles, teams and trucks; non-owned and both on and off the site of work.

Subcontractors: Contractor shall cause each Subcontractor to purchase and maintain insurance of the types and amounts specified herein. Limits of such coverage may be reduced only upon written agreement of County. Contractor shall provide to County copies of certificates of insurance evidencing coverage for each Subcontractor. Subcontractors' commercial general liability and business automobile liability insurance shall name County as Additional Insured and have the Waiver of Subrogation endorsements added.

Proof of Carriage of Insurance - The Contractor shall furnish the County with Certificate(s) of Insurance which name the County as additional insured in an amount as required in this contract. The Certificate of Insurance shall provide that there will be no cancellation, non-renewal or reduction of coverage without 30 days prior written notice to the County. In addition, such insurance shall be on an occurrence basis and shall remain in effect until such time as the County has made final acceptance of the services provided.

INDEMNITY AGREEMENT: To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the County, its directors, officers, agents, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses (including but not limited to attorney's fees) arising by reason of any act or failure to act, negligent or otherwise, of Contractor, of any subcontractor (meaning anyone, including but not limited to consultants having a contract with contractor or a subcontract for part of the services), of anyone directly or indirectly employed by contractor or by any subcontractor, or of anyone for whose acts the contractor or its subcontractor may be liable, in connection with providing these services. This provision does not, however, require contractor to indemnify, hold harmless, or defend the County of Boone from its own negligence.

Nothing in these requirements shall be construed as a waiver of any governmental immunity of the County, its officials nor any of its employees in the course of their official duties.

Failure to maintain the required insurance in force may be cause for contract termination. In the event the Agency/Service fails to maintain and keep in force the required insurance or to obtain coverage from its subcontractors, the County shall have the right to cancel and terminate the contract without notice.



COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR BACKUP EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS AND DISPATCH FACILITY ACCESS BETWEEN BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI AND UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI-COLUMBIA, MISSOURI

THIS AGREEMENT dated the *I* day of *Gebruary* 2023, is entered into by and between Boone County, Missouri (Boone County), and The Curators of the University of Missouri , by and through the University of Missouri–Columbia Police Department (MUPD):

WHEREAS, Boone County provides emergency communications and dispatching services for multiple first responder agencies located within Boone County; and

WHEREAS, MUPD provides emergency communications and dispatching services for MUPD; and

WHEREAS, Boone County serves as the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) within its corporate geographic boundaries for purposes of the 911 system; and

WHEREAS, Boone County typically answers 911 calls for service that result in MUPD being dispatched; and

WHEREAS, in addition to its primary facility at the Emergency Communications Center, 2145 County Drive, Columbia, MO 65202, Boone County maintains a backup emergency communications and dispatch facility in Columbia, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, MUPD typically dispatches from its primary facility at 901 Virginia Avenue, Columbia, Missouri 65211, and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the continuity of emergency communication and dispatch services in the event MUPD is unable to provide such services at its primary facility due to an emergency such as a fire, flood, earthquake, attack, sabotage, equipment malfunction, or any other cause, Boone County wishes to provide MUPD access to Boone County's backup facility for emergency communication and dispatching purposes; and

WHEREAS, the parties have the authority to enter this agreement pursuant to the provisions of RSMo Sec. 70.220;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure the continuity of emergency

communications and the response to 911 calls during periods of emergency in which MUPD is temporarily unable to provide for its own emergency communications and dispatch services at its primary facility. Under this Agreement, Boone County will provide access to appropriate MUPD staff so they can temporarily provide emergency communications and dispatch services from Boone County's backup facility until MUPD's normal service can be restored at its primary dispatch location.

- 2. BACKUP COMMUNICATIONS FACILTY ACCESS. In the event an emergency occurs that results in the inability of MUPD to provide emergency communications and dispatch services in response to 911 calls at its own primary facility, access to Boone County's backup emergency communications facility shall be provided as follows:
 - a. MUPD will contact Boone County to advise Boone County of the need for access to the backup facility. Boone County will advise MUPD of Boone County's ability to provide access to Boone County's backup facility and, if Boone County is in a position to provide access, all 911 emergency communications services for MUPD shall be switched to the MUPD staff in place at Boone County's backup facility.
 - b. The backup facility access contemplated herein shall be provided until MUPD indicates that such access is no longer required, either because of restoration of normal functionality at MUPD's primary location or the relocation of appropriate personnel to some other MUPD backup facility. Boone County reserves the right to limit access to its backup facility; however, if Boone County requires the use of the backup facility to provide its emergency communication and dispatch services or other County services.
 - c. It is understood that each party to this Agreement has finite resources and that access to the County's backup communications facility may not be able to be provided in all circumstances. It is also understood that Boone County's backup facility may not be able to provide service at the same level as MUPD normally provides during any temporary service period. Boone County makes no guarantees or warranties of any kind to MUPD regarding the availability of the backup facility or the level of service that can be provided from said facility.
 - d. The parties agree that the technical, operational details of how services shall be provided under this Agreement shall be as agreed upon between the Boone County's Joint Communications Director and MUPD's Police Chief or their designee and that those staff shall develop mutually acceptable standard operating procedures to implement the services contemplated by this Agreement.

- 3. **COMPENSATION.** Mutual aid assistance provided under this Agreement shall be rendered without charge to either party.
- 4. LIABILITY. Each party shall be responsible for all claims, damages, and losses sustained by its own personnel. Neither party shall be liable to the other for any action, failure to act, delay, mistake, failure to respond, negligence, or failure to effectively handle any policy problem arising out of any assistance provided hereunder. Each party's employees or agents shall be subject to all provisions of law, and retain the same status as an employee or agent, as if those employees or agents were providing services within each party's own jurisdiction.
- 5. **TERM AND TERMINATION.** The term of this Agreement shall begin immediately upon execution of the same for a period of one year, and shall automatically renew for successive periods of one year if not terminated as provided for herein. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing the other written notice of their intent to terminate at least ninety (90) days in advance of the intended termination date.
- 6. **ASSIGNMENT.** Neither party may assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement to any other person or entity without the prior, written consent of the other party.
- 7. SOLE BENEFIT OF PARTIES. This Agreement is for the sole benefit of Boone County and MUPD. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to confer any rights or remedies on any third party.
- 8. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** Nothing herein shall be deemed or construed by the parties hereto, nor by any third party, as creating the relationship of principal and agent, or of partnership, or of joint venture, between the parties hereto.
- 9. **MODIFICATION AND WAIVER.** No modification or waiver of any provision of this Agreement nor consent to any departure therefrom, shall in any event be effective, unless the same shall be in writing and signed by Boone County and MUPD and then such modification, waiver or consent shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose for which mutually agreed.
- 10. **FUTURE COOPERATION**. The parties agree to fully cooperate with each other to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of this Agreement.
- 11. **COUNTERPARTS AND SIGNATURES.** This agreement may be signed in one or more counterparts each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together shall constitute one and the same document. Faxed signatures, or scanned and

electronically submitted signatures, on this Agreement or any notice delivered pursuant to this Agreement shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as original ink signatures on this Agreement.

- 12. **NOTICES.** Notice of the need for backup services and of the end of that need will be in person, by telephone, or by such other means as may be reasonably used to apprise the backup party of the initiating party's need for services. All other notices under this Agreement, with the exception of equipment testing, shall be given in writing, addressed as follows:
 - a. To Boone County: Director, Boone County Joint Communications, 2145 E. County Drive, Columbia, Missouri 65202.
 - b. To MUPD: Chief of Police, MUPD, 901 Virginia Ave, Columbia, Missouri 65211.
- 13. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. The parties state that this document contains the entire agreement between the parties, and there are no other oral, written, express or implied promises, agreements, representations or inducements not specified herein.
- 14. **AUTHORITY.** The signatories to this Agreement warrant and certify that they have obtained the necessary authority, by resolution or otherwise, to execute this Agreement on behalf of the named party for whom they are signing.





Application for Appointment to Boone County Children's Services Board

The Boone County Children's Services Board was established in 2013 with the passage of a special sales tax levy in November, 2012. The Board, in partnership with the Boone County Commission. is charged with making Boone County a better and healthier community through the provision of services to protect the well-being and safety of children under the age of nineteen (19) and their families. The Board's goal is to maximize positive outcomes in a transparent, accountable fashion in recognition of the fact that the taxpayers of Boone County are an important stakeholder and beneficiary of this program. 'The Board's partnership with the Boone County Commission allows it to benefit from the ability to hire dedicated, professional staff with competitive salary and benefits packages into a professional environment with supports that include facilities maintenance. purchasing, human resources, legal, auditing, and other organizational supports and synergies that stem from being integrated into Boone County government as a County department. This partnership also allows the Boone County taxpayers to benefit from a coordination of social service spending at the County level in order to avoid duplication of effort, ensure efficient spending of public resources, and increase transparency. Finally, being part of County government allows the Children's Services sales tax proceeds to retain its character as "local tax dollars," allowing for the pursuit of matching federal dollars through various federal programs administered through the State Department of Mental Health, State Department of Social Services, and other federal matching programs.

Composition of the board of directors must meet the statutory requirements of the enabling legislation. Additionally, persons appointed to the board must comply with the provisions of the bylaws of the board and the conflict of interest policies promulgated by the County Commission and the Board. As appointees of a statutorily created Board with powers to direct the expenditure of public funds, board members have certain fiduciary duties, which require that they conduct themselves without conflict to the interest of the Children's Services Board or the Boone County taxpayer. Certain types of conflicts of interest are not prohibited, but disclosure is critical. Disclosure should not be construed as creating a presumption of impropriety or as automatically precluding someone from participation. Rather, it reflects the recognition of the many factors that can influence one's judgment and a desire to make as much information as possible available to other participants. Potentially conflicting interests may relate to programs and services or operations, such as contracts with third parties.

For purposes of this policy, "affiliated organizations" are those organizations which are controlled by or have systemic legal relationships with an agency who receive funds from the Children's Services Fund. [For example, two entities controlled by the same Board of Directors or the same administration team or an entity that relies on another almost exclusively for its financial support.
