Type of Incident: Sobriety Checkpoint

Incident Occurred: Shalimar Drive at Highway 763

Date & Time: 07/25/2008 at 2300 hours to 07/26/2008 at 0300 hours

Details of the Incident: On 07/25/2008, the Boone County Sheriff's Department conducted a Sobriety Checkpoint on Shalimar Drive and Highway 763, in Columbia.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department conducted the checkpoint in conjunction with the Hallsville Police Department and Columbia Police Department and with the support of the Boone County, MO., Chapter of Mothers Against Drunk Driving (M.A.D.D.).

During the sobriety checkpoint, the following actions were taken:

- 5 arrest for driving while intoxicated – alcohol
- 1 arrest for driving while intoxicated - drugs
- 7 arrest for driving with a suspended or revoked license
- 1 arrest for operating a motor vehicle without a valid license
- 1 arrest for fail to comply with ignition interlock restriction
- 3 arrests for possession of controlled substance
- 4 summons issued for no insurance
- 2 summons for failure to register
- 1 summons for no seatbelt

Approximately 318 vehicles were checked during the checkpoint. The Boone County Sheriff's Department wishes to thank the citizens of Boone County, MO., for their patience and cooperation during this operation.

All suspects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
