Media Release LEAVING THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT

Details;

On 02-18-09 at 7:16 P.M. a deputy with the Boone County Sheriff's Department discovered that a vehicle had struck the gas pumps at the Boone County Sheriff's Department, 2121 County Drive. The driver of the vehicle had left the scene of the accident. It was later determined that the vehicle had been taken while parked in the parking lot at the Sheriff's Department without the owner's consent.

Deputies located the suspect, 45-year-old James Jones of Columbia, walking near the area of the accident. At this time Deputies discovered Mr. Jones had a revoked driver's license and he was under the influence of alcohol. Mr. Jones was arrested for Tampering 1st Degree with a bond set at \$4,500.00, Leaving the Scene of an Accident with a bond set at \$4,500.00, Driving While Revoked with bond set at \$500.00, and Driving While Intoxicated with bond set at \$500.00.



All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
