Incident: Burglary & Manufacture of Controlled Substance
Location: 4400 Block Bellview Dr. & 1600 Block of Westwinds Dr.
Date & time: 3-3-09 @ 0845
Case Number: 09-1392 (burglary), 09-1394 (Manufacture of Controlled Substance)

Details:

On 3-3-09 at about 0845 hours deputies with the Boone County Sheriff's Department were dispatched to a burglary in progress at an apartment in the 4400 block of Bellview Drive in Southeast Columbia.

A resident of the apartment was asleep and woke when he heard glass break in the apartment. He went to investigate the sound and encountered 3 males standing in the kitchen of the apartment. When he encountered the suspects, all three left the apartment and got into a car waiting outside. The resident then saw a female standing next to the car waiting for the males.

The suspects fled the area before deputies arrived on scene. The resident of the apartment recognized one of the men as an acquaintance he met through his roommate. This information allowed deputies to quickly locate all 4 suspects at an apartment in the 1600 block of Westwind Dr.

After making contact with the suspects inside the apartment on Westwind Drive, deputies observed marijuana plants being grown inside the apartment.

All the suspects were detained, as well as a fifth person at the apartment who had been implicated in the crime. During interviews that followed, deputies received statements that implicated all 5 people detained were involved in either the planning of, or the commission of the burglary.

The following suspects were arrested in connection with this burglary:

17 year-old Clinton T. Bradley of Columbia, 18 year-old Mark A. Rose of Columbia, 18 year-old Westley C. Wilburn of Columbia, 19 year-old Tanya M. Gould of Columbia. The fifth suspect was a 16 year-old female from Columbia.

Clinton Bradley and Westley Wilburn were also arrested for Manufacture of a Controlled Substance.

Bonds on all charges must be set by a judge. As of the time of this press release no bond has been set for any of the suspects.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
