Incident: Meth lab discovered during traffic stop  
Location: 22000 Block of Dinwiddie School Road

#### Details:

On 4-04-09, the Boone County Sheriff's Department Proactive Patrol Unit was on assignment near Centralia, Missouri. They were patrolling an area known for recent methamphetamine activity.

About sixteen minutes after midnight, they stopped a car in the 22000 block of Dinwiddie School Road. There were three adult occupants in the vehicle who were all known to the deputies as being associated with methamphetamine activity in Boone County. One of the occupants, David Harmon, had recently been arrested on 3-11-09 by the Sheriff's Department for another meth lab.

Further investigation revealed components of a methamphetamine lab inside the vehicle. A quantity of finished methamphetamine and syringes were also found.

#### Arrested were:

- Forrest Daniel Lyons, age 26 of Hallsville, for creation of a controlled substance (methamphetamine).
- David Lewis Harmon, age 36 of Centralia, for manufacturing a controlled substance (methamphetamine) and possession of a controlled substance (methamphetamine).

The third occupant was released pending further investigation. Additional charges are possible.
