Incident: Felony Arrest - Driving While Intoxicated
Location: Highway 63, near Route B
Date & time: 04-21-2009 at about 10:52 p.m.

Details:

On 04-21-2009 at about 10:50pm, a Deputy observed a vehicle driving northbound on Highway 63, near Route B. Several traffic violations were observed. The vehicle weaved between the lanes of traffic and at times, drove as slow as 20 miles per hour on Highway 63.

The vehicle was traffic stopped and the driver was identified as William P. Cayce Jr., a 51 year old resident of Jefferson City, Mo. Following a roadside investigation, Cayce was arrested for suspicion of Driving While Intoxicated (DWI).

Cayce had a revoked Missouri driver's license due to several active ten year denials from the Missouri Department of Revenue. Cayce was convicted of Driving While Intoxicated four times in a two year period. The convictions were on 09-21-2004, 10-26-2004, 10-05-2005, and 09-05-2006. The third and fourth convictions were felonies.

Cayce was also on parole and classified as an aggravated Driving While Intoxicated offender.

Cayce was arrested for the following:
Driving While Intoxicated, Chronic Offender (felony)
Driving While Revoked (misdemeanor)

Cayce's bond about for the Driving While Revoked charge was \$500.00. As a class B felony, the bond amount for the DWI charge must be set by a judge. At the time of this press release, the bond had not been set at Cayce's request.
