### Media Release

Incident: Armed Criminal Action; Assault 2nd Law Enforcement Officer; Assault 3rd Law Enforcement Officer; Resisting Arrest; Domestic Assault 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Child Endangerment 1st

#### Details:

On 05/15/09 at approximately 1730 hours, Boone County Sheriff's Department Deputies were dispatched to the New Haven Meadows Subdivision for an assault in the area. Upon arriving, the initial investigation revealed the suspect, 31 year old Columbia resident Danielle Renee Kelly, had struck her boyfriend with her vehicle.

Kelly drove at a high rate of speed through the subdivision, intending to strike her boyfriend, who was walking with Kelly's juvenile son. The vehicle grazed the boyfriend's leg as it traveled over the curb. Kelly's son was not injured.

When told she was under arrest, Kelly became agitated and attacked the two deputies on scene, biting one on the arm. Deputies were able to gain control of Kelly and placed her under arrest for: Armed Criminal Action (by way of a vehicle), Domestic Assault 1st degree, Child Endangerment 1<sup>st</sup> degree, Assault of a Law Enforcement Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Assault of a Law Enforcement Officer 3rd degree, and Resisting Arrest. The deputy was treated for a superficial bite wound and was back to work a short time later.

**All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.**
