Media Release Disturbance, Stolen Vehicle Recovered

Incident: Domestic Disturbance
Location: 200 block of Catherine Dr., Rock Bridge Estates Subdivision
Date & time: 06-15-2009 at about 3:50 a.m.

Details:

On the morning of 06-15-2009, deputies responded to a domestic disturbance in the 200 block of Catherine Drive. Earlier in the evening, the female complainant made an assault report to the Columbia Police Department. She returned home around 3:50 a.m., and observed the male suspect outside their residence. The female left the area in her vehicle.

When deputies arrived in the area, they made contact with the male half, Deangelo Nicholas Porter, an 18 year old resident of Columbia. Deangelo was operating a vehicle reportedly stolen on 06-05-2009 from a residence in the 5500 block of Bethel Lane. Deangelo also had two outstanding warrants. Deangelo was arrested and transported to the Boone County Jail.

Deangelo was arrested for the following:

- One count of First Degree Tampering (felony), \$4,500 bond.
- Warrant for Probation and Parole violation (original charge misdemeanor assault), \$10,000 cash bond.
- Warrant for Probation and Parole violation (original charge misdemeanor domestic assault, misdemeanor endangering the welfare of a child), \$4,000 cash bond.

Additional felony charges from the Columbia Police Department are pending at the time of this release.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
