Details:

On Wednesday, September 2, 2008 a Kansas City Missouri man was arrested by Boone County Court Security Officers after the suspect turned himself into the Boone County Court on an active arrest warrant charging him with three counts of the attempted Sexual Misconduct Involving a Child Under 15.

This arrest stems from an undercover investigation initiated in late October 2008. At that time the suspect contacted whom he believed to be a fourteen year old Boone County girl but was actually an investigator with the Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force. The suspect is accused of contacting the decoy child through the Internet on several occasions through March of 2009 and on at least three separate occasions exposed his genitals to her for the purpose of sexual gratification. In May 2009, after verifying the identity and location of the suspect, investigators with the Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force contacted the suspect at his home in Kansas City. On August 27, 2009 the Boone County Prosecuting Attorney's Office filed charges against the suspect in Boone County Circuit Court.

The suspect is identified as 40 year old Raymond E. Bishop Jr. of 1419 NE Vivian Road, Apartment 26, Kansas City, Missouri. At the time of this investigation the suspect was reportedly working for the University of Missouri at Kansas City. The suspect was released after posting a \$60,000 bond. No photograph is available.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
