Incident: Guilty Plea  
Location: Miami Florida

Details: On Wednesday, September 2, 2009 an Ohio man pleaded guilty in Miami Florida to attempting to violently dunk children underwater for his own sexual pleasure after an investigator with the Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force testified at his trial.

In April 2007 an undercover investigator with the Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force posing as a Boone County mother was contacted by the suspect in an Internet chat room. After learning the Boone County woman had a 12 year old daughter the suspect offered to pay the woman to allow the suspect to hold the child under water in her bathtub as he became sexually aroused.

In July 2007 the Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force investigator was contacted by Secret Service investigators in Miami who were also conducting an undercover investigation involving this same suspect. In late July 2007 the suspect flew to Miami to meet that undercover mom with the intention of engaging in the same activity with her two children ages 12 and 9. The suspect was arrested at the Miami airport after giving an undercover female officer \$500 to "dunk" her girls and suggesting they purchase Velcro straps as he left his behind in Ohio for fear they would be confiscated by airport security.

On the third day of trial the Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force investigator was in the process of testifying about her contact with the suspect when the Court took a break. During the break the suspect reportedly agreed to a 20 year prison term. The suspect reportedly could have received up to 90 years in prison if convicted by the jury.

The suspect is identified as 47 year old Jeffrey Doland of Uniontown, Ohio.
