Media Release Drug Violation

Incident: Possession w/ Intent to Distribute Marijuana, Resisting Arrest
Location: 300 block of Glenstone Drive, Columbia, MO

Details: On 10-14-09, at approximately 0009 hours, a Deputy with the Boone County Sheriff's Department initiated a traffic stop of a vehicle for vehicle license violation in the 300 block of Glenstone Drive near the intersection of Hillsdale Road, Columbia, MO. The driver of the suspect vehicle exited and fled the scene on foot with the Deputy pursuing. After a short foot pursuit and search of the area, the suspect was not located. During an inventory search of the suspect vehicle, a quantity of marijuana was located. Subsequent investigation and items of evidentiary value located in the vehicle led Deputies to an apartment located on Keene Street where 25-year old Jonathan Ryan March of Hallsville, MO., was located and arrested without incident. Items of evidentiary value located in the apartment linked March to the suspect vehicle. Sheriff's Deputies were assisted by officers with the Columbia Police Department and Missouri State Highway Patrol.

March was arrested for Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Distribute, Resisting Arrest, and Failure to Register a Motor Vehicle. Bond for the drug violation has yet to be set. Bond was set at \$4,500.00 and \$95.00 respectively for the remaining offenses.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
