Incident: Arrest-Possession of Child Pornography  
Location: 1515 Liberty Street, Columbia, MO  
Case Number: 2009-1857

Details: On Wednesday late morning, October 28, 2009 Detectives with the Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force and Boone County Sheriff's Department arrested a 23 year old Columbia man on suspicion of the possession of Child Pornography.

This arrest is the result of a Mid-Missouri Internet Crimes Task Force investigation that began in December 2008. At that time a Task Force detective established that a computer in the Columbia area was suspected of offering child pornography and the detective traced the location of the computer to a residence in East Central Columbia. On April 21, 2009 Task Force detectives, including detectives from the Boone County Sheriff's Department and Columbia Police Department, served a Court ordered search warrant at the Columbia residence where several computers were sized. As a result of the examination of the seized evidence and interviews conducted with the occupants of the residence a suspect was identified. During the examination of the computers and associated media seized, approximately 47 videos depicting the sexual molestation of children were located. Some of the victims in these videos are believed to be as young as five or six years of age.

The suspect is identified as twenty-three year old Jordan Wood of 1515 Liberty Street, Columbia, Missouri. At the time of this release the suspect is in the Boone County Jail pending the filing of formal charges. A photograph of the suspect is not available at this time.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
