Type of Incident: DWI Saturation

Incident Occurred: Lake of the Woods Area, Columbia

Date & Time: 11/13/2009 at 2300 hours to 11/14/2009 at 0300 hours

Details of the Incident: On 11/13/2009, the Boone County Sheriff's Department conducted a DWI (Driving While Intoxicated) Saturation in the Lake of the Woods area. During this time, Deputies saturated the area to detect and enforce the DWI laws of Missouri.

During the saturation, the following actions were taken:

- 6 arrests for driving while intoxicated
- 2 arrests for driving with a suspended or revoked license
- 2 arrests for outstanding warrants
- 1 arrest for endangering the welfare of a child
- 1 arrests for adult liquor law violations
- 3 summonses for hazardous moving violations
- 6 summonses for non-hazardous moving violations

The following warnings were issued:

- 18 warnings for hazardous moving violations
- 23 warnings for non-hazardous moving violations

Hazardous moving violations include stop sign/signal light violations, lane violations, careless and imprudent driving, speeding, etc. Non-hazardous moving violations include registration violations, equipment violations, operating vehicle without a valid driver's license, etc. Approximately 40 vehicles were stopped during the saturation. The Boone County Sheriff's Department wishes to thank the citizens of Boone County, MO., for their patience and cooperation during this operation. Funding for the saturation came from the MO Department of Transportation, Division of Highway Safety.

All suspects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
