Incident: 2 Burglaries w/4 Arrests
Location: Georgetown Subdivision
Date & time: 5/5/10 @ 1115 hours

Details:

Two men and two male juveniles were taken into custody earlier today (5/5/10) in connection with a pair of burglaries in the Georgetown subdivision located off Scott Boulevard, just outside the Columbia city limits.

At about 1115 hours, sheriff's deputies and Columbia Police officers responded to the 5100 block of Georgetown Drive after a citizen reported seeing four males coming out of a neighbor's house. The citizen provided a description of the suspects and the vehicle in which they left the scene, a tan 1999 four-door Chrysler Concorde.

A Columbia Police officer responding to the call located the vehicle near the intersection of West Gillespie Bridge Road and Chapel Hill Road. Two of the suspects, a 14-year-old male and 17-year-old James Miller were spotted walking nearby and taken into custody.

A short time later, a 15-year-old male was taken into custody on Longview Drive and 17-year-old Drake Kinney was captured at a residence in the 4500 block of Bethany Drive. Miller, of 610 Spencer Ave., and Kinney were being held in the Boone County Jail on charges of Burglary in the Second Degree, Felony Stealing, Resisting Arrest and Property Damage. The 14-year-old and 15-year-old males were turned over to juvenile authorities.

During the course of the Georgetown Drive incident a resident in the 1400 block of Pickford Drive reported returning home and discovering a burglary. The 34-year-old woman told officers her back door had been forced open and three laptop computers, a flat screen TV and and two cameras were missing.

Those items, along with property taken from the Georgetown Drive residence, were recovered from the Concorde. All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Sheriff's Department is grateful to the Columbia Police Department for their assistance in the arrest of the suspects and the recovery of both victims property.

Mugshots of the adult suspects were not available at the time of this release.
