Incident: Pursuit of Stolen Automobile

Location: Boone County Fairgrounds

Date & time: 08/06/10 0943

Details:

On 08/06/10 the Boone County Sheriff's Department had several deputies assigned to various security details both inside and outside the Boone County Fairgrounds for the National Biker's Rally. One of these deputies was equipped with a license plate reader (LPR) in her patrol vehicle.

At approximately 0945 hours, the LPR alerted the deputy to a registration on a vehicle listed as stolen. The deputy notified other law enforcement officers and deputies in the area of the alert and continued to follow the vehicle. The vehicle left the area of the fairgrounds, and continued South on Highway 63. Just south of the Broadway exit, the vehicle accelerated rapidly. Deputies and several members of the Missouri State Highway Patrol pursued the vehicle through southern Boone County, at times reaching speeds in excess of 100 miles per hour.

Just south of the Boone/Callaway County line, MSHP Troopers deployed tire deflation devices. The driver lost control of the vehicle and slid off the shoulder on the West side of the road. Law enforcement personnel from both agencies continued the chase on foot, and were able to apprehend the driver almost immediately. The other two passengers fled into the wooded area surrounding the bluffs.

MSHP Troopers located the two remaining passengers walking South on Highway 63 later in the afternoon.

Calvin Cortez Jones, 30 year old Kansas City, Kansas resident was arrested for: Tampering 1st degree, Felony Resisting Arrest, Driving while Revoked, Careless and Imprudent Driving, and Failing to Yield to an Emergency Vehicle. Mr. Jones' bond was set at \$9,790.00.

Twenty-five year old Christian A. Moore, and 21 year-old Willie Bradford, both residents of Kansas City, Kansas, were each charged with Tampering 2nd degree and resisting arrest. Their bonds were set at \$1,000.00 each.
