Incident: Vehicle Pursuit
Location: Eastbound Interstate 70 near U.S. Highway 63 connector

Details;

On the evening of December 28, 2010, at approximately 8:00 P.M., the Boone County Sheriff's Department's Pro-Active Patrol Unit attempted to stop a vehicle for a traffic violation on eastbound Interstate 70 near the U.S. Highway 63 connector. The vehicle failed to yield and a vehicle pursuit ensued.

The pursuit continued on eastbound Interstate 70 until the suspect vehicle reached Route Z, where it exited the interstate and began traveling eastbound on I70 Drive Southeast. The suspect vehicle left the roadway in the 10000 block of I70 Drive Southeast and traveled through the lawn of a residence in the area before it stopped in a wooded area. The driver fled on foot but was apprehended after a brief foot pursuit.

Deputies took 31-year-old Columbia resident David Singleton Jr., into custody for the following offenses:

Possession of a controlled substance (methamphetamine),
Driving while driver's license suspended,
Careless and imprudent driving,
Resisting/Interfering with Arrest for a Felony,
Third Degree Assault of a Law Enforcement Officer,
with a total bond set at \$10, 500.

Singleton, who is currently on parole in the state of Missouri, was also being held on a no-bond Parole Violation.

All suspects are to be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
