Media Release RESISTING ARREST, DRUGS

Incident: Resisting arrest and drug offenses
Location: 200 Block of Havens Road

Details:

On 01-02-2011 at 6:38 P.M. a Boone County Sheriff's Department Deputy assigned to the Traffic Unit observed a vehicle driving in a careless and imprudent manner near the intersection of Brown School Road and Clearview Road. The vehicle had driven into the other lane of traffic to pass 3 vehicles that were waiting at the stop sign at the top of the hill. The Deputy attempted to conduct a traffic stop with the vehicle regarding the traffic offense.

The vehicle began to travel at a high rate of speed in an attempt to elude the Deputy. The Deputy pursued the vehicle for a short period until the occupants of the vehicle stopped and fled the area. After a short amount of time, the Deputy located both occupants of the vehicle and took them into custody.

It was later determined that the driver of the vehicle, 27-year-old Andre London of Columbia, did not have a valid driver's license.

The passenger of the vehicle, a 16-year-old juvenile, also fled the vehicle when it stopped. The juvenile was found to be in possession of a package of Cocaine and had previously been reported as a runaway. When the juvenile was detained and placed in the patrol vehicle, he kicked the assisting Deputy in the leg. The Deputy was not injured during this incident.

Mr. London was arrested for Careless and Imprudent Driving with a bond of \$500.00, Operating a Vehicle without a Valid Operator's License with a bond of \$300.00, Littering with a bond of \$500.00, Resisting Arrest with a bond of \$500.00, and Endangering the Welfare of a Child 2nd Degree with a bond of \$500.00.

The juvenile was referred to the Juvenile Justice Authorities for Runaway, Assault 3rd Degree against a Law Enforcement Officer, Resisting Arrest, and Possession of a Controlled Substance. The juvenile was detained by Juvenile Justice Authorities at the Juvenile Justice Center.

No photo of the juvenile will be made available.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
