Details:

Boone County sheriff's deputies arrested four people tonight (5/26/11) after serving search warrants on two residences on East St. Charles Road in connection with numerous burglaries at an office building on Trade Winds Parkway earlier in the day.

Angela K. Clayton, 22, of 4611 E. St. Charles Road, was arrested on suspicion of Receiving Stolen Property, four counts of Forgery, Felony Endangering the Welfare of a Child and Distribution of a Controlled Substance.

Kelsey C. Skouby, 22, of 4611 E. St. Charles Road, was arrested on suspicion of Receiving Stolen Property, Felony Endangering the Welfare of a Child and Distribution of a Controlled Substance. Both Clayton and Skouby were being held in the Boone County Jail awaiting bond to be set.

Deputies also arrested Nathan A. Clayton, 21, and James L. Walters, 46, of 4609 E. St. Charles Road on a misdemeanor charge of Possession of a Controlled Substance and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Both were being held in the Boone County Jail on \$1,000 bond each.

This morning deputies responded to Magnuss Enterprises at 620 Trade Winds Parkway after employees arriving for work at numerous businesses reported burglaries. Magnuss Enterprises is a large office building and complex housing different companies.

Approximately \$5,000 worth of electronics, computer equipment, office equipment and a flat screen TV taken in the burglaries were recovered during the search warrants that were executed at about 6 p.m.

Mugshots of the suspects were not available at the time of this press release. All suspects are considered innocent until proven otherwise in a court of law.
