Incident: Drug related search warrant
Location: 4703 Highway HH Apt. B, Boone County, Missouri
Date & time: 5-27-11 @ 9:00 am

Details:

On the above date and time the Boone County Sheriff's Department served a Boone County search warrant at 4703 Highway HH Apt. B in Boone County, Missouri. An investigation into the activities in the neighborhood led deputies to believe the residents of the apartment were involved in an active and on-going illegal drug distribution operation. This search warrant was the culmination of that investigation.

Both cocaine and marijuana were located at the residence. Evidence of distribution of those drugs was also found including digital scales, packaging material, and a large amount of cash.

A loaded .40 caliber handgun was also located in the residence. An investigation into who owns the gun continues. Regardless, Larry E. McBride Jr. is forbidden to possess any firearm by the State of Missouri because he is a convicted felon.

At time of this incident, McBride was also on Missouri parole for drug related charges. These charges are related to an incident on 4-18-07 where McBride was the driver of a car on Grindstone Parkway in which Tedarrian Robinson, a passenger, was shot and killed.

Today's incident occurred in the same neighborhood where the murder of Donnell Coleman occurred on 4-17-11. Donnell Coleman's murder remains unsolved. The Sheriff's Department is still actively investigating the murder and requests anyone with information about the murder contact the Sheriff's Department.

Arrested were:

Larry E. McBride, age 24, of Columbia for two counts of distribution of a controlled substance, RsMO 195.211 and one count of a felon in possession of a firearm, RsMO 571.070.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
