Incident: Methamphetamine lab discovery
Location: 5407 Kelsey Drive, Columbia, Missouri

Details:

On the above date and time, the **Boone County Sheriff's Department Proactive Saturation Unit** along with the **Columbia Police Department Street Crimes Unit** went to the above location and arrested Blake Robbins and Christine Poynter. Both individuals had outstanding felony warrants for their arrest.

Both Robbins and Poynter were located and taken into custody. An active methamphetamine lab was also located at the residence. Finished methamphetamine, methamphetamine paraphernalia, chemicals, and other components of a meth lab were located both outside and inside the residence.

A four year-old child was also inside the residence. An uncapped syringe lying on the floor and a drinking glass containing acid on a low bedroom table are examples of the specific dangers this lab presented to the child.

Arrested were:

Blake Allan Robbins, age 24, of Columbia was charged with Manufacturing a Controlled Substance RsMO 195.211, Endangering the Welfare of a Child RsMO 568.045, and three outstanding warrants.

Christine Amber Poynter, age 30, of Columbia was charged with Manufacturing a Controlled Substance RsMO 195.211, Endangering the Welfare of a Child RsMO 568.045, and one outstanding warrant.

Booking photographs were not available at the time of this release.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
