Incident: Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, Resisting Arrest  
Location: Brown School Rd. near Highway 63  
Date & time: 11-01-2011 at about 9:20 p.m.

#### Details:

On the evening of 11-01-2011, a deputy traffic stopped a vehicle on Brown School Road near Highway 63. As the vehicle came to a stop, the passenger fled from the vehicle. While doing so, the passenger dropped a loaded revolver outside the vehicle. The passenger was apprehended south of the sheriff's department by a responding deputy.

The passenger was identified as Quinton James Vaughan, a 21 year old resident of Columbia.

Vaughan was arrested for the following:

1. Unlawful possession of a firearm (felony).
2. Resisting arrest (felony).
3. Possession of less than 35 grams of marijuana (misdemeanor).

Vaughan was taken to the Boone County Jail for processing. He remains in custody with a \$9,500 bond.

In 2009, Vaughan received a felony conviction for distribution of a controlled substance. In the state of Missouri, it is illegal for a convicted felon to possess a firearm.

The driver of the vehicle was released. All subjects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. An updated booking photograph is included below.
