Media Release

Incident: Drug related search warrant
Location: 201 East Texas Avenue, Red Roof Inn, Room 212

Details:

On the above date and time the Boone County Sheriff's Department assisted by the Columbia Police Department served a Boone County search warrant at the Red Roof Inn, Room 212. The Sheriff's Department working with the Columbia Police Department developed information that the occupants of the room were manufacturing methamphetamine and a search warrant was requested and issued.

A complete and active methamphetamine lab was located inside the motel room. Items located included chemicals, equipment, meth paraphernalia, and finished methamphetamine. The condition of the manufacturing process when located represented a significant danger to other guests and employees of the motel. The meth lab and motel room were made safe by deputies trained to safely handle such situations.

Two occupants of the motel room were arrested:

- Charles G. Albiol, age 34, of Columbia for manufacturing a controlled substance, RSMo 195.211
- Brenda L. Albiol, age 35, of Columbia for manufacturing a controlled substance, RSMo 195.211
