Incident: Stolen Vehicle Pursuit
Location: North East Columbia
Date & time: 07/25/12 1920

Details:

On 07/25/12 at approximately 1920 hours one of the License Plate Reading apparatus indicated a stolen vehicle from Columbia was headed East on I-70 from the Midway area. Boone County Sheriff's Deputies responded and attempted to stop the vehicle.

The driver, 25 year old Columbia resident, Keith C. Brim, refused to stop and led deputies on a chase through the I-70/63 connector and throughout northeast Columbia. Officers from the Columbia Police Department and Troopers from the Missouri State Highway Patrol assisted in the pursuit and ensuing events.

Mr. Brim traveled towards his address in the 1600 block of Hanover Boulevard, occasionally reaching speeds in excess of 70 miles per hour in densely populated areas. After driving through yards in the Hanover area, he drove the stolen vehicle over a large set of concrete steps. The vehicle became high centered and he fled into a nearby building with deputies in pursuit.

After a brief time, Mr. Brim exited the building and surrendered himself to deputies on scene. Mr. Brim was transported to the Boone County Jail and booked on the following charges: Tampering First Degree (Felony), Resisting Arrest (Felony), Property Damage First Degree (Felony), and Driving While Suspended (Misdemeanor) Total bond for these four charges is \$25,000.00. Mr. Brim also had two out of county felony warrants totaling \$14,500.00, bringing his total bond to \$39,500.00.
