### Media Release Vehicle Pursuit

Incident: Vehicle Pursuit  
Location: New Haven Road at Warren Drive

#### Details:

On the evening of March 1, 2013, at about 9:42 p.m., the Boone County Sheriff's Department's Pro-Active Unit initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle for a traffic violation in the area of New Haven Road and Warren Drive. The suspect vehicle did not stop for officers and a vehicle pursuit ensued.

The pursuit traveled east on New Haven Road, then north on Rolling Hills Road. In the area of Rolling Hills Road and Highway WW, a sheriff's deputy successfully deployed a tire deflation device. The suspect vehicle entered the Arbor Falls subdivision and came to a stop on Bower Lane. The driver fled from the vehicle and engaged in a struggle with several deputies before being taken into custody.

The driver was identified as Daniel Peek, a 23-year-old resident of Columbia. The passenger was identified as Daria Littleton, a 35-year-old resident of Columbia.

Peek was arrested for the following offenses:

Resisting Arrest (Felony,) Missouri RSMO 575.150;  
Possession of a controlled substance (methamphetamine,) Missouri RSMO 195.202;  
Possession of drug paraphernalia, Missouri RSMO 195.233;  
Careless and Imprudent driving, Missouri RSMO 304.012;  
Failure to Yield to an Emergency vehicle, Missouri RSMO 304.022;

Peek's total bond was set at \$10, 145.00.

Littleton was released from the Boone County Jail with summonses for Possession of less than 35 grams of marijuana, Missouri RSMO 195.202 and for Possession of drug paraphernalia, Missouri RSMO 195.233.
