Incident: Shots Fired/Pursuit/Recover Stolen Property
Location: 9900 Block Route J

Details:

On 04-30-2013 at about 8:00 p.m., deputies responded to several citizen reports of a vehicle traveling south in the 9000 block of Route J. Several of the occupants were observed shooting from the vehicle.

Deputies caught up to the vehicle in the area of Route J and Highway 40. An attempt to stop the vehicle resulted in a pursuit southbound on Route J and Route O. The vehicle turned onto Roby Farm Rd. and drove down a long private drive before stopping. Two of the four occupants were immediately taken into custody. The other two occupants fled into a wooded area.

Deputies, along with M.S.H.P. personnel, utilized a department K-9 to search for the two outstanding occupants. They were not located.

Stolen property, including a firearm, was recovered from the vehicle.

The remaining two occupants are being sought by deputies. At this time, their identities are not being released.

All subjects should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

Marland M. Lane, a 22 year old resident of Columbia, was arrested for the following:

- Receiving Stolen Property (felony)

Jamil H. Edwards, a 21 year old resident of Columbia, was arrested for the following:

- Receiving Stolen Property (felony)
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (misdemeanor)
