Incident: Recover Stolen Vehicle and Property

Location: 130 mile marker I70 eastbound

Details:

On July 17, 2013 at about 2211 hours, a Boone County Sheriff's Department Deputy was alerted to a vehicle with stolen license plates, by an automatic license plate reader. The license plates had been reported stolen to the Lincoln, Nebraska Police Department on 07/13/2013.

The vehicle was traveling eastbound on Interstate 70 and with the assistance of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, was stopped near the 130 mile marker. The driver and lone occupant of the vehicle, Joseph R. Vance of Belle Isle, Florida, was taken into custody without incident.

The stolen license plates were displayed on a 2002 Chevrolet Impala. The vehicle was found to be stolen, in regards to a different case, out of Lincoln, Nebraska, on 07/11/2013. There were several items inside the vehicle that were recovered, that had also been stolen during separate thefts, all occurring in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Vance was processed for Tampering with a Motor Vehicle 1st Degree (RSMo 569.080), Receiving Stolen Property (RsMO 570.080) and Operate a vehicle on Highway without a Valid License (RsMO 302.020). Vance's total bond was set at \$5,300. At the time of this release, Vance remains in custody at the Boone County Jail.

All suspects should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
