Incident: Vehicle Pursuit
Location: Vandiver Drive @ Highway 63

Details:

On November 4, 2013, at approximately 0043 hours, a deputy with the Boone County Sheriff's Department attempted to stop a vehicle for a traffic violation in the area of Vandiver Drive at Highway 63. The vehicle failed to yield and a pursuit ensued. The vehicle traveled north on Vandiver Drive then east on Mexico Gravel Road. As the vehicle approached the roundabout at Mexico Gravel Road and Ballenger Lane, the driver lost control and struck a curb causing all four tires to deflate. The vehicle came to rest and all four occupants attempted to flee on foot.

The driver of the vehicle, 28 year-old Maurice Robinson of Columbia, Missouri; and two passengers, 24 year-old Duran Griffith of Columbia, Missouri; and 22 year-old Dushane Griffith of Columbia, Missouri; were quickly taken into custody after fleeing a short distance. The third passenger, a juvenile, was apprehended a short time later with the assistance of a Boone County Sheriff's Department K9 Unit.

Maurice Robinson was arrested for the following: Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Resisting Arrest, Driving While Revoked, Property Damage, Careless and Imprudent Driving, and Speeding. Mr. Robinson's total bond was \$7000.00.

Dushane Griffith and Duran Griffith were both taken into custody for Resisting Arrest. Their total bond was \$500.00 each.

The juvenile was detained by the Juvenile Office.

All subjects should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
