Incident: Burglary/Assault
Location: 7400 Block of Moberly Drive

Details:

On 1-30-14 deputies with the Boone County Sheriff's Department responded to the 7400 block of Moberly Drive to investigate the report of an assault. During the course of the investigation, deputies learned 22 year-old Marissa Davis of Columbia, Missouri, and 22 year-old Alicia Cole, also of Columbia, came to the residence in search of a subject with the intent of assaulting her.

Davis and Cole saw the victim standing outside the residence and attempted to confront her. The victim ran inside and attempted to close the door. Davis and Cole pushed past the door and assaulted the victim causing minor injury. During the altercation, the suspects damaged the victim's property. There was a minor child inside the residence in close proximity during the commission of the crime. Davis and Cole left the area before law enforcement arrived.

The victim refused medical attention and the child was not injured.

Davis and Cole were later contacted and arrested during a traffic stop by the investigating officer. Both were arrested for 1st Degree Burglary, 3rd Degree Assault, 2nd Degree Property Damage and 2nd Degree Endangering the Welfare of a Child. Bond for the Burglary must be set by a judge. Total bond for the other charges was set at \$1500.00.

Photographs of the suspects were not available at the time of this release.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
