Media Release ROBBERY

Incident: Robbery, Assault, and Resisting
Location: 200 Block of Snead Drive
Date & time: 07-29-2014 @ 3:59 P.M.

Details:

On 07-29-2014 at 3:59 P.M. Boone County Sheriff's Department Deputies were dispatched to the 200 Block of Snead Drive regarding a disturbance. Upon arrival, Deputies learned the victim had been walking in the area when a male subject took his video game console and began to run. The victim began to chase the subject when another person assaulted him. The victim was surrounded by several other subjects, both male and female, who continued to assault him.

During the investigation, Deputies identified two subjects who were involved in this incident. They were identified as Lorenzo Shephard Jr., 18-years-old from Columbia, and David Canady, 17-years-old of Columbia. After determining Mr. Shephard would be arrested for this incident, he attempted to evade Deputies. A Deputy took control of Mr. Shephard before he was able to leave the area. They were arrested for the following charges:

Mr. Shephard: Robbery 2nd Degree with a bond of \$15,000.00, Assault 3rd Degree with a bond of \$500.00, and Resisting Arrest with a bond of \$4,500.00.

Mr. Canady: Robbery 2nd Degree with a bond of \$15,000.00, Assault 3rd Degree with a bond of \$500.00.

The remaining subjects involved in this incident have not been identified yet.

All subjects should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
