Details:

On Monday, October 27, 2014, a 41 year old Jarrod Hoffman of Columbia, Missouri was sentenced to 7 years in prison for the possession of child pornography.

The investigation began in mid-August 2013 when an investigator with the Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force downloaded child pornography from a home computer network believed to be in the Columbia, Missouri area. The computer connection was traced to a specific residence and on August 30, 2013 a court ordered search warrant was served at a residence located on Alpine Drive in Columbia. As a result computers and various electronic media were seized. During subsequent examinations of the electronic devices, over 30 videos depicting the sexual molestation of children some as young as toddlers were recovered and as a result of the ongoing investigation a suspect was identified.

On November 22, 2013 the Boone County Prosecuting Attorney's Office charged Jarrod D. Hoffman with Possession of Child Pornography and was arrested shortly after the issuance of the warrant.

The defendant is identified as 41 year old Jarrod Hoffman of Columbia, Missouri.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force is comprised of investigators from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the University of Missouri Police Department, and the Federal Bureau of Investigations.
