#### Details:

A 26-year-old man was arrested by Boone County sheriff's deputies on suspicion of burglary, property damage and assault stemming from an incident last night (12/16/14) in the 16000 block of James Sapp Road in the Ashland area.

Ryan D. Lieneke, of Morrision, Mo., is in the Boone County Jail awaiting bond to be set on a charge of First Degree Burglary. Lieneke also faces charges of First Degree Property Damage and Assault in the Third Degree. Bond on those charges total \$5,000.

At about 11:30 p.m. deputies were dispatched to the residence on James Sapp Road after the victim reported Lieneke was breaking down his front door. The 33-year-old victim told deputies the suspect was able to gain entry to the home and then assaulted him.

The suspect fled the residence but was taken into custody a short distance away by a Missouri State Highway Patrol trooper who was responding to the scene. The suspect and the victim are known to each other and the incident is believed related to a previous dispute between the men. The investigation is continuing.
