Incident: Vehicular Pursuit

Details:

A 36-year-old Columbia man with outstanding warrants was taken into custody and hospitalized after leading Boone County sheriff's deputies on a pursuit early this morning (7/6/15) in northeast Columbia.

Deputies received information that David L. Singleton, of Columbia, was travelling to a residence in the 4400 block of Hinkson Creek Road. Deputies spotted Singleton near the residence at about 0140 hours driving a 1993 Ford pickup truck and attempted to make a traffic stop.

The truck accelerated its speed on Hinkson Creek Road and then turned on Mexico Gravel Road. The pursuit continued on Mexico Gravel Road, crossed Paris Road and then onto Browns Station Road.

The suspect then drove into Elm Grove Trailer Park where it struck a parked vehicle and a chain link fence. The suspect exited the vehicle and fled on foot. A canine unit from the Columbia Police Department performed a track and the suspect was found nearby in Park Village Trailer Court.

Singleton was transported to a local hospital after making statements that concerned deputies. Singleton had outstanding warrants for Failure to Appear and Failure to Follow a Judge's Order.
