Incident: Child Pornography Arrest

Location: Cole County

Details:

On Friday, July 17, 2015, a 30 year old, Cole County man was arrested on child pornography charges.

This is direct result of the Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force, the Jefferson City Police Department and the Cole County Prosecuting Attorney working together to protect children.

The investigation leading to this arrest began in mid-April when an investigator with the Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force downloaded over 50 child pornography files from a computer located in Jefferson City, Missouri.

On July 17, 2015 a court ordered search warrant was served at a Jefferson City residence. As a result, computers and other media were seized. During the search warrant a Task Force investigator conducted an overview search of several items, locating multiple videos depicting the sexual molestation of prepubescent children.

The suspect is identified as 30 year old Jeffrey M. Curry of 810 Wildwood Drive, Apt 21, Jefferson City, Missouri. The suspect was arrested on suspicion of Promoting Child Pornography 1st degree and the Possession of Child Pornography (2nd offense-1 video or 20 still images). Bond is to be set. No picture available for this release.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force is comprised of investigators from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the University of Missouri Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigations and the Boone County Prosecuting Attorney's Office.
