Incident: Motorcyclist Arrested After High Speed Chase
Location: Rangeline Road and Highway WW

Details:

Boone County sheriff's deputies arrested a Columbia man early this morning (8/28/15) after a high speed chase ended when the suspect crashed his motorcycle into a deputy's patrol vehicle near Highway WW and Rangeline Road.

Leslie Dwayne Shoemate, 41, of 2401 Norbury Drive, faces charges of felony resisting arrest, felony driving under revocation and careless and imprudent driving. Shoemate was released from the Boone County Jail after posting a \$9,500 bond.

The pursuit began when Shoemate, driving a Honda CVR 1000 motorcycle, passed deputies at a high rate of speed near Vandiver Drive and Rangeline Road in Columbia shortly after 2 a.m.. The chase continued on Vandiver Drive with the suspect then heading south on Highway 63.

The pursuit continued at speeds in excess of 100 miles per hour and reached Ashland, Mo. The suspect exited at Highway Y and then proceeded north from Ashland back onto Highway 63. The suspect turned east on Highway AB and then north on Rangeline Road to Highway WW.

At Rangeline Road and Highway WW the suspect attempted to evade a deputy but collided with a patrol vehicle and was thrown from the motorcycle. After a brief foot chase the suspect was taken into custody. No deputies were injured but the patrol vehicle struck by the suspect incurred moderate damage.
