Incident: Vehicle pursuit with crash
Location: 6400 Block of I-70 Drive Southeast

Details:

On 10-1-15 at about 1500 hours, a Boone County deputy sheriff was alerted the a vehicle displaying a stolen license plate by an automated license plate reader. The vehicle was driving eastbound on Interstate 70 and the deputy attempted to stop the vehicle near the Rangeline Street exit.

The driver of the vehicle failed to stop and led the deputy on a pursuit. The driver of the suspect vehicle drove off of Interstate 70 and attempted to drive onto I-70 Drive Southeast. The driver lost control of the car and it left the roadway and overturned in a single vehicle crash. The driver then ran from the crash.

Boone County deputies, officers from the Columbia Police Department, and the Missouri State Highway Patrol arrived in the area and helped establish a perimeter. A canine unit arrived at the scene and began tracking the suspect. The suspect was located and taken into custody about ¼ mile from the scene of the crash.

The suspect received minor injuries in the crash and was transported to a local hospital for evaluation. Arrested was 39 year-old Timothy L. Scott of Broomfield, Colorado. Mr. Scott was arrested for the following crimes:

Tampering 1st Degree, Receiving Stolen Property, Resisting arrest, Possession of a controlled substance, Possession of drug paraphernalia, Possession of certain weapons, Property damage, Driving while revoked, and Careless and Imprudent driving resulting in an accident. Total bond for these charges is \$29,000.00.
