Incident: Deputies Arrest Two After Vehicle Pursuit
Location: City of Columbia/Boone & Callaway Counties

Details:

Two people were arrested early this morning (11/30/15) including one with felony warrants by Boone County sheriff's deputies after a vehicle pursuit that ended in Callaway County.

At about 0309 hours, a blue Acura 2.2 CL sedan fled from Columbia police officers who attempted to stop the vehicle in the 1400 block of Rangeline Street. The suspect's vehicle travelled east on Interstate 70 where a deputy began a pursuit. The Acura exited the interstate at Highway HH in Callaway County and then proceeded onto County Road 220.

The suspect's vehicle came to a stop after a Callaway County sheriff's deputy set out a tire deflation device at the intersection of County Roads 213 and 220. Four individuals inside the vehicle were taken into custody.

The Acura's driver, Stephan M. Reed, 24, of 7363 N. Oakland Gravel Road, was arrested on suspicion of Receiving Stolen Property after deputies located a laptop computer reported stolen from the University of Missouri. Reed was also arrested on suspicion of Felony Resisting Arrest and for outstanding warrants on charges of First Degree Robbery and First Degree Property Damage.

Another passenger in the Acura, Meghan B. Glover, 22, of Columbia, was turned over to Columbia Police for an outstanding municipal warrant. Two other passengers in the vehicle, a man and a woman, were released.
