ORDER OF PROTECTION / WEAPON VIOLATION / DRUGS

Incident: Order of Protection, Drug, and Weapon Violations
Location: 6200 Block of Nelson Dr

Details:

On 01/01/2016 at 1:12 P.M. Deputies with the Boone County Sheriff's Department were dispatched to an adult order of protection violation in the 6500 block of North Browns Station Road.

It had been reported the suspect, 50 year old William Cockrell of Columbia, displayed a black handgun as he violated the terms of an adult order of protection. Mr. Cockrell moved into a residence less than 150 feet from the petitioner's house.

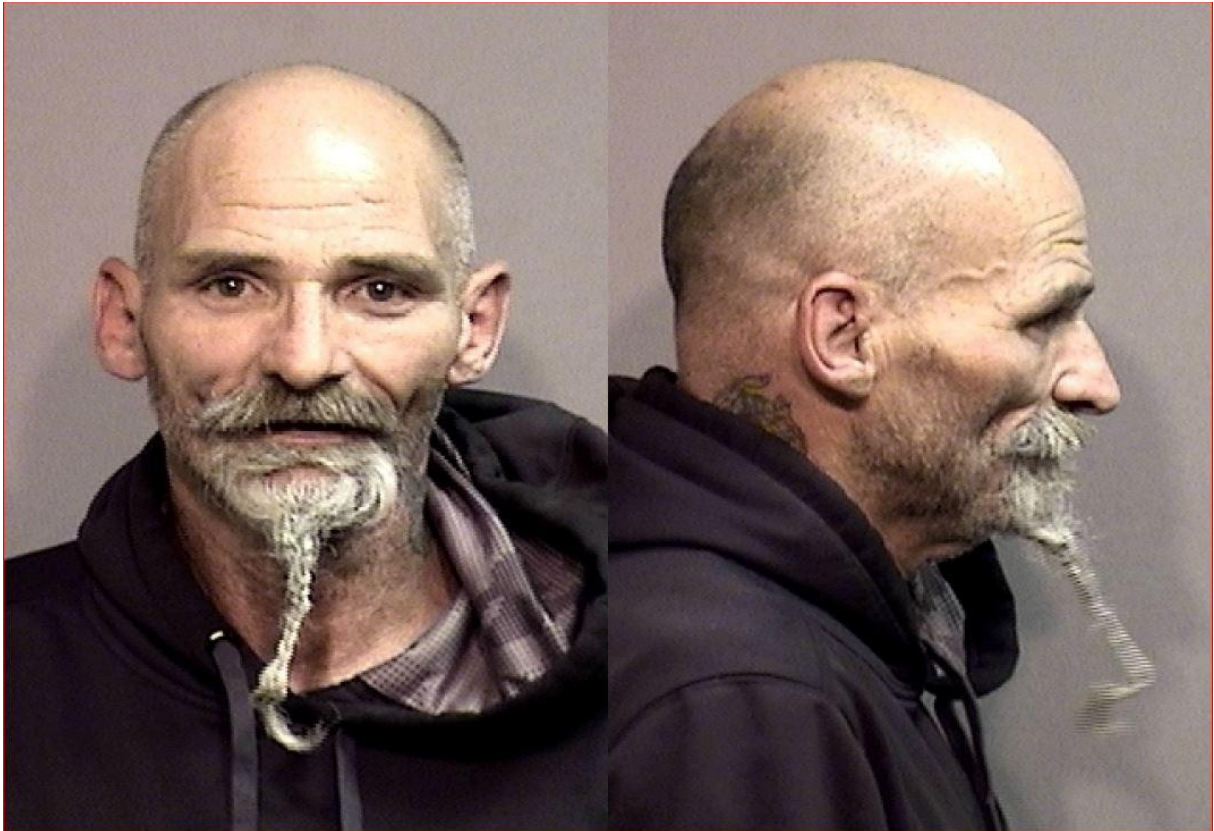
Deputies located Mr. Cockrell in the 6200 block of Nelson Drive. Mr. Cockrell was in possession of narcotics, including methamphetamine, cocaine, marijuana, and prescription pills. The black semi-automatic handgun previously described by a witness was found in Mr. Cockrell's vehicle. Mr. Cockrell is a convicted felon.

Mr. Cockrell was arrested for the following charges:

Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance – RSMo 195.202
Unlawful Possession of a Weapon – RSMo 571.070
Ex Parte / Order of Protection Violation – RSMo 455.085
Possession of Drug Paraphernalia – RSMo 195.233
Possession Less Than 35 grams Marijuana – RSMo 195.202

Mr. Cockrell's total bond is \$11,000.

All subjects should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
