### Media Release Drug Arrest

Incident: Possession of a controlled substance/Resisting Arrest  
Location: 2800 block of Blue Ridge Road

#### Details:

On 02-26-16, at approximately 1721 hours, deputies with the Boone County Sheriff's Department's Pro-Active Investigation Unit arrested a Jefferson City, Mo., man who ran from his vehicle as the deputies tried to initiate a traffic stop in the 2900 block of Blue Ridge Road. The deputies attempted to stop the man because they were aware his driver's license was revoked and as a result of an on-going investigation into potential drug activity in the area.

After a short foot pursuit, the deputies apprehended 52-year-old Donald Wolverton. Lying on the ground near the area where Mr. Wolverton was taken into custody was a quantity of methamphetamine. A search of Mr. Wolverton's vehicle yielded various items of drug paraphernalia related to the use of marijuana and methamphetamine.

Mr. Wolverton was arrested for the following offenses:

Possession of a controlled substance, Missouri RSMO 195.202;  
Operated motor vehicle while driver's license revoked, Missouri RSMO 302.321;  
Resisting/Interfering with arrest, Missouri RSMO 575.150;  
Unlawful use of drug paraphernalia, Missouri RSMO 195.233.

Mr. Wolverton's total bond was set at \$6,000.

At the time of his arrest, Mr. Wolverton was on probation for Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance and Second Degree Domestic Assault.

A current booking photo was not available at the time of this release.
