Incident: Burglary, Stolen Vehicle, Drugs, Resisting Arrest
Location: McGill Pointe Estates, Rocheport Area

Details:

A non-compliant registered sex offender wanted as a parole absconder was arrested earlier this week by Boone County sheriff's deputies on suspicion of burglary, vehicle theft, possession of drug paraphernalia and resisting arrest.

Deputies were dispatched to the 3900 block of McGill Pointe Drive on 4/12/16 at 1210 hours for a report of an abandoned vehicle. The deputy discovered the vehicle, a black 2008 Mercury Mariner, was reported stolen from Columbia on 4/11/16. While investigating on McGill Pointe Drive a deputy was told by a citizen that a suspicious man was walking in the area. The deputy made contact with Dennis J. Bunn, 35, who then fled into nearby woods. After a short foot chase Bunn was taken into custody and was found to have a small amount of a substance believed to be methamphetamine in his possession.

About ninety minutes later a homeowner in the nearby 3100 block of N. McGill Creek Road reported a burglary at their residence. Cash and jewelry were found in a wooded area behind the residence along with a pipe containing methamphetamine residue and a Missouri Identification Card belonging to Bunn.

Bunn was transported to a local hospital after telling deputies he ingested a controlled substance. He was released last night (4/13/16) and transported to the Boone County Jail. Bunn is presently being held without bond.
