### Media Release Stolen vehicle

Incident: Stolen Vehicle Pursuit  
Location: 4800 block of Clark Lane  
Date & time: 11/13/2016 @ 1705 hours

#### Details:

At approximately 1705 hours, deputies were alerted by an Automated License Plate Reader, of a stolen vehicle (white Toyota) from Kansas City, MO, that was traveling eastbound on Interstate 70, through Boone County. Deputies, with the assistance of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, located the Toyota at St Charles Rd and I70 Dr Southeast. Deputies attempted to stop the Toyota and it fled, eastbound on St Charles Rd. The vehicle continued through a neighborhood and it became apparent that there were actually two vehicles fleeing from deputies. The lead vehicle (gray Honda), stopped in a cul-de-sac and the occupants fled. Deputies stayed with the Honda and determined that it was also a stolen vehicle out of Independence, MO.

The pursuit of the Toyota continued, west on St Charles Rd. The vehicle almost struck a patrol vehicle, as it drove through a yard and sidewalk and back onto the roadway. The Toyota then went westbound Clark Ln and almost struck two vehicles. The Toyota passed a vehicle on the right, struck the curb and lost control. The Toyota crashed and came to rest in the eastbound lane of Clark Lane. Two occupants fled on foot from the Toyota.

The driver of the Toyota was apprehended in the area and was identified as Jarrell D. Brown of Kansas City, MO.

A K9 track was attempted with the assistance of the Columbia Police Department, but the outstanding suspects were not located.

Mr. Brown was arrested for the following offenses:

Tampering in the first degree, in violation of Missouri RSMO 569.080

Resisting Arrest, in violation of Missouri RSMO 575.150

Careless and Imprudent Driving, involving a crash, in violation of Missouri RSMO 304.012

Operated a Motor Vehicle without a Valid Driver's License, in violation of Missouri RSMO  
302.020
