Incident: Defendant Sentenced—10 years

Location: Boone County

Case Number: 2014-2028

Details:

On Monday, July 31, 2017, defendant Daniel Teare of New York was sentenced in Boone County court on 2 counts Promoting Child Pornography 1st degree (10 years each count) and 10 counts of Possession of Child Pornography (10 years each count), all to be served concurrent to all counts. The defendant was found guilty during a 2-day jury trial beginning June 20, 2017.

Original Case:

On February 27, 2015, a former Columbia man, Daniel Teare, was arrested in Saratogo County New York, on an arrest warrant for 2 counts of Promoting Child Pornography and 1 count of Possession of Child Pornography.

The investigation began April 21, 2014, when a Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force detective was investigating the distribution of child pornography through the Internet and subsequently downloaded multiple child pornography videos from a computer located in Boone County. In addition, the Task Force received information that a detective from the Independence Police Department had download multiple child pornography videos on April 24, 2014 from the same location.

On May 16, 2014 detectives served a court ordered search warrant at a residence located in Boone County and seized multiple electronic items.

A forensic examination was conducted on all items seized from the residence leading to evidence that linked the defendant to the child pornography downloads which were being disseminated from the residence in April.
