Incident: Man Arrested- Possession of Child Pornography

Location: 5300 Block of Steeplechase Drive

Details:

On Friday, March 9, 2018, a Boone County man was arrested for 1 count Possession of Child pornography, Class D felony

The investigation leading to the arrest began when an investigator downloaded child pornography from a computer located in Columbia.

The Task Force served a court ordered search warrant today at a Columbia residence and seized several pieces of evidence. During an on-scene search, the Task Force forensic examiner located evidence of child pornography.

The suspect is identified as 48-year-old, David Elliott who resides at 5303 Steeplechase Drive located in Columbia, Missouri. Bond was set at \$4500.00.

This investigation is ongoing.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force is comprised of investigators from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the University of Missouri Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigations, and the Boone County Prosecuting Attorney's office.
